Leviticus 22:4–7

None of the offspring of Aaron who has a leprous disease or a discharge may eat of the holy things until he is **clean**.



Leviticus 22:4–7

Whoever touches anything that is **unclean** through contact with the dead or a man who has had an emission of semen,

and whoever touches a swarming thing by which he may be made **unclean** or a person from whom he may take **uncleanness**, whatever his **uncleanness** may be...

Leviticus 21:1

No one shall make himself unclean
for **the dead** among his people,



Leviticus 21:1–3

No one shall make himself unclean
for the dead among his people,
**except for his closest relatives, his mother, his father, his
son, his daughter, his brother, or his virgin sister (who is
near to him because she has had no husband; for her he
may make himself unclean).**



Leviticus 21:10–11

The priest who is chief among his brothers...
He shall **not** go in to any dead bodies
nor make himself unclean,
even for his father or for his mother.



Leviticus 21:5

They shall not make **bald patches** on their heads,
nor shave off the edges of their **beards**,
nor make any **cuts** on their body.



Leviticus 21:7

They shall not **marry a prostitute** or a woman who has been **defiled**, neither shall they marry a woman **divorced** from her husband, for the priest is holy to his God.



Leviticus 21:13–14

And he (**Great High Priest**) shall take a **wife in her virginity**.
A widow, or a divorced woman, or a woman who has been
defiled, or a prostitute, these he shall not marry.
But he shall take as his wife a virgin of his own people



Leviticus 21:17

Speak to Aaron, saying, None of your offspring throughout their generations who has a **blemish** may approach to offer the bread of his God.



Leviticus 21:18–20

For no one who has a blemish shall draw near, a man **blind** or **lame**, or one who has a **mutilated face** or a **limb too long**, or a man who has an **injured foot or an injured hand**, or a **hunchback** or a **dwarf** or a man with a defect in his **sight** or an **itching disease or scabs or crushed testicles**.

so that he may be able to give instruction in sound
doctrine and also to rebuke those who contradict it.
