PRAY:

SAY:

The goal is to proclaim the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. It is not just about building relationships; it's about building relationships to the point where spiritual conversation can take place, and you can bring the gospel to them.

In short, being missional is to be intentional in building relationship with people around you, where you live, work and play, so that gospel conversation can take place! May you be found faithful today as salt and light, wherever God has placed you!
