Church Plant FAQ

1. Why plant a new church?

- a. The Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20) Local churches are the most effective channel for God to fulfil His Great Commission (making disciples of all nations).
- b. Centred on the Gospel (1 Corinthians 2:2, 9:16, Romans 1:16, Acts 20:24)

While Singapore has many churches, not all are centred on the Gospel. We need more Gospel-centred churches to reach more people with the Good News.

c. Spiritual growth (Galatians 4:19, Colossians 1:28-29, Ephesians 4:11-12)

New churches provide greater growth opportunities, focusing on life-on-life ministries, leading to spiritual growth for all involved.

2. Why a Chinese church?

a. The burden of the church planters
Pastor Kay Hong and his wife May have served in China
for many years and have a good understanding of the
Chinese culture. They have shepherded the Chinese
congregation at Gospel Light for a year and a half, giving
them a special burden for the Chinese-speaking
community.

b. New immigrants

Singapore has around 1 million new immigrants with Chinese as their mother tongue from China, Malaysia, Taiwan, and Hong Kong. This calls for more Chinese-speaking churches.

c. Meeting their needs

New immigrants often have various needs when entering a new environment. They seek acceptance and a community to belong to, which can be addressed through a Chinese-speaking church.

3. What is the church vision?

A Gospel Centred Church (以福音为中心的教会)

4. What is the church mission?
