

LOOK AT DADDY

In giving my children instruction over the years, whether it was learning to write, play a sport or a practical skill, the most common words I've used to guide their focus were, "Look at Daddy..." Modelling instruction for our watching children, is an intentional way to guide our kids. Calling our children to watch us carry out an action provides the important example for them to imitate.

In our age of out-source parenting, how often do the words "Look at Daddy" become, "Look at someone else..." Outsourcing fatherhood isn't intentionally harmful, after all you've had a long day at work and you've earned the right to come home and sit in your armchair, put up your feet and watch your favorite streaming service. Haven't you already expressed your love by providing a home, tutors, toys? But expecting your child to 'look at' someone else for a model of life instruction, reflects a misplaced priority for our children's spiritual formation. We need fathers who want to live lives worthy of their children to watch. Paul was able to say "follow my example" because his life was worthy of imitation. (1 Cor. 11:1)

Here are three ways you can model a godly fatherhood before your watching children:

Look At Daddy's Love for God

Elevate your relationship with God as the most precious. Dedicate yourself to cultivate spiritual disciplines: an intimate walk with God, marked by a regular devotional life, prayer, consumption of scripture, serving the body of Christ and discipleship. These are not habits of grace that come naturally, and godly fathers make effort to find spiritual community, and accountability to sharpen them.

Look at Daddy's Love for Mummy

It has been said that the greatest thing a father can do for his children is to love their mother. Our biblical basis for this is God's mandate for husbands to love their wives as Christ loves the church (Eph. 5:25). There is no relationship that your children will observe more closely than your marriage to their mother. There is no relationship that will test you as much as your marriage. And there is no human relationship that will define your fatherhood as much as how you sacrificially love the mother of your children.

Look at Daddy's Love for You

Let your children know you love them. Let them know your love aspires to be a reflection of God's lavish love for sinners (2 Cor. 5:21). Let your children see your love for them in the way you invest time in your relationship. Be their biggest cheerleader and encourager. Affirm them for who they are, without expecting them to fulfill your dreams or life expectations. Our children need our affection, attention and friendship.

While we labor to live out a godly picture of intentional fatherhood, remember that our labors never promise a child's salvation. But neither do our failures condemn a child from knowing God. Instead, as we seek to fulfil our role as fathers, may we commit the outcome to our heavenly Father and find in Him our truest joy and reward.


