- Supervise contractors to ensure work performance are of acceptable standard and in accordance with work specifications
- Oversee the building maintenance of our buildings in Dunearn Road as well as at Punggol
- Handle administration duties such as calling for quotations and documentations
- Perform other duties that may be assigned from time to time
