

Forsaken for Forgiveness Psalm 22



My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? (Psalms 22:1a)





And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?" that is, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"

(Matthew 27:46)

My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? Why are you so far from saving me, from the words of my groaning? I cry.. you do not answer, ... I find no rest.

Yet...

(Psalms 22:1-2)



Yet you are holy, enthroned on the praises of Israel. In you our fathers trusted; .. you delivered them.. they cried and were rescued; in you they trusted and were not put to shame.

But..

(Psalms 22:3-5)



But I am a worm and not a man, scorned by mankind and despised by the people. All who see me mock me; they make mouths at me; they wag their heads; "He trusts in the LORD; let him deliver him; let him rescue him, for he delights in him!"

Yet..

(Psalms 22:6-8)



Yet you are he who took me from the womb; you made me trust you at my mother's breasts. On you was I cast from my birth, and from my mother's womb you have been my God.

(Psalms 22:9-10)



for trouble is near, and there is none to help... strong bulls of Bashan surround me.. like a ravening and roaring lion. I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint; my heart is like wax; it is melted within my breast; my strength is dried up like a potsherd, and my tongue sticks to my jaws; you lay me in the dust of death. (Psalms 22:11-15)



For dogs encompass me; a company of evildoers encircles me; they have pierced my hands and feet.. they divide my garments among them, and for my clothing they cast lots.

Only the part of suffering and agony...



Matthew 27:35,39,41-43,46
And when they had crucified him, they divided his garments among them by casting lots. ...And those who passed by derided him, wagging their heads ...



So also the chief priests, with the scribes and elders, mocked him, saying, "He saved others; he cannot save himself. He is the King of Israel; let him come down now from the cross, and we will believe in him. He trusts in God; let God deliver him now, if he desires him. For he said, 'I am the Son of God.'"
