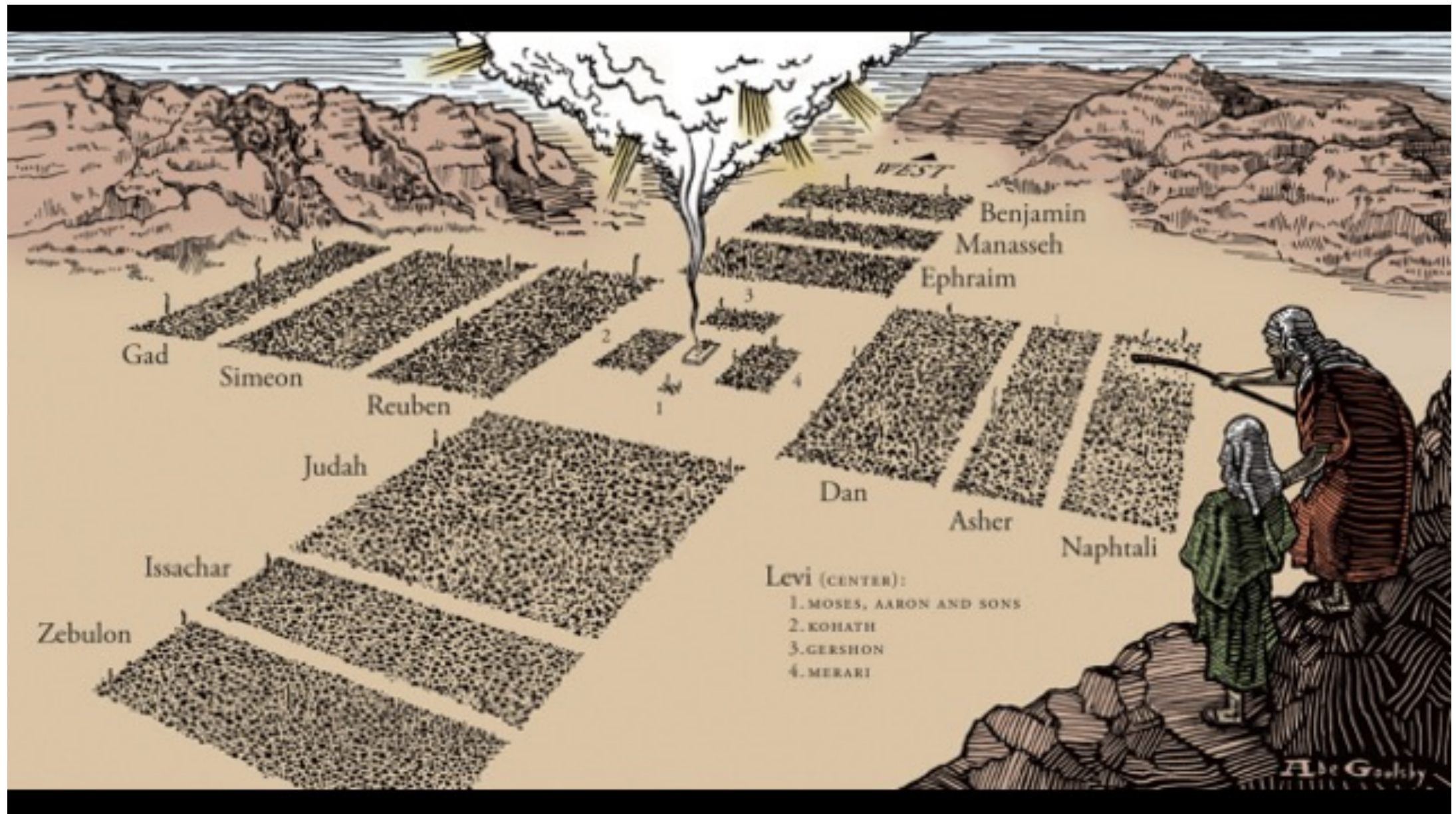

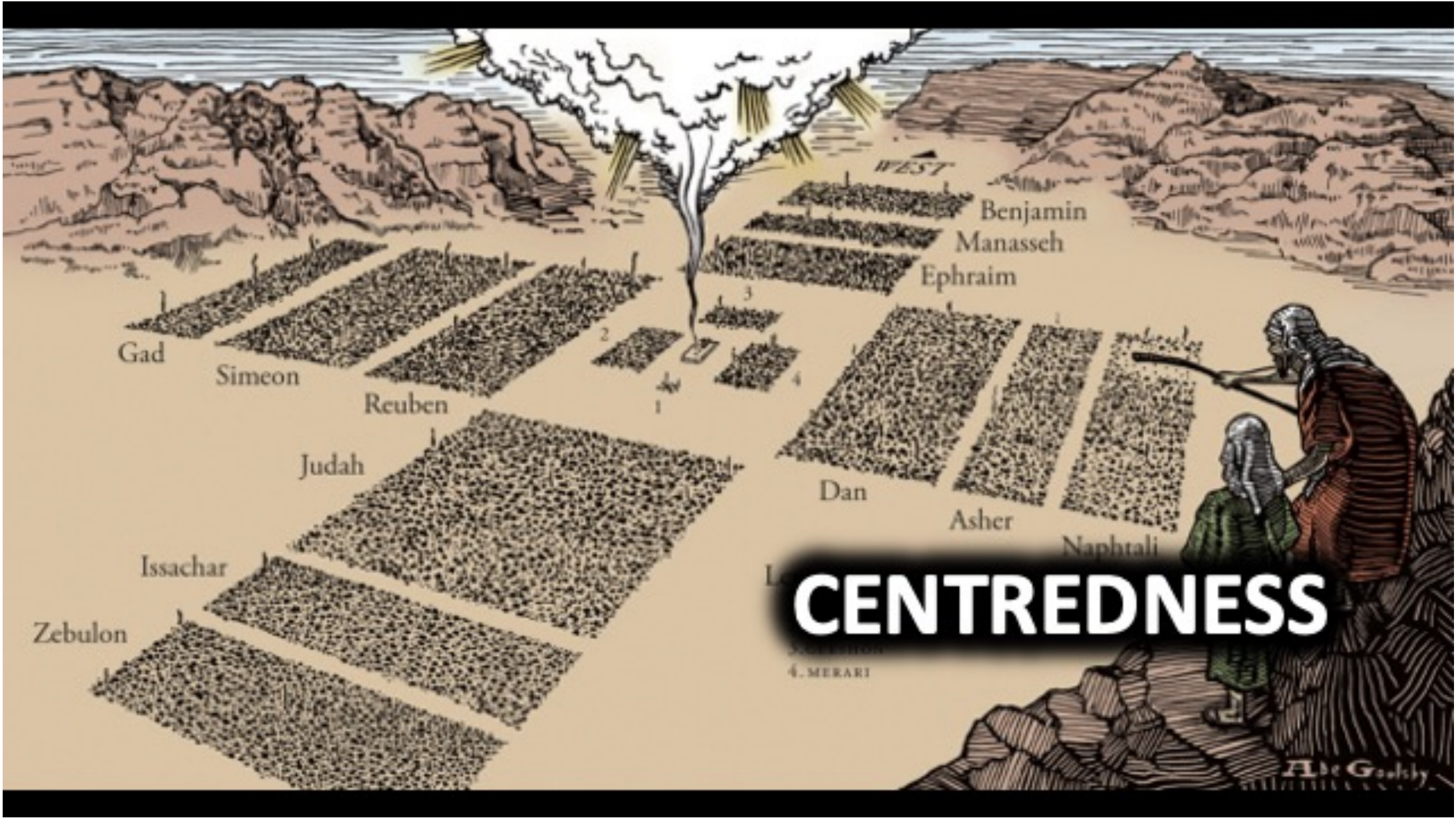

Numbers - Chapter 7

Numbers 7:2–3

the chiefs of Israel... brought their offerings before the LORD,
six wagons and twelve oxen...



Numbers 7:88

and all the cattle for the sacrifice of peace offerings twenty-four bulls, the rams sixty, the male goats sixty, the male lambs a year old sixty. This was the **dedication offering for the altar** after it was anointed.



Numbers 7:12–17

And his offering was one silver plate whose weight was 130 shekels, one silver basin of 70 shekels, according to the shekel of the sanctuary, both of them full of fine flour mixed with oil for a **grain offering**; one golden dish of 10 shekels, full of incense; one bull from the herd, one ram, one male lamb a year old, for a **burnt offering**; one male goat for a **sin offering**; and for the sacrifice of **peace offerings**, two oxen, five rams, five male goats, and five male lambs a year old.

For all the firstborn among the people of Israel are mine, both of man and of beast. On the day that I struck down all the firstborn in the land of Egypt I consecrated them for myself



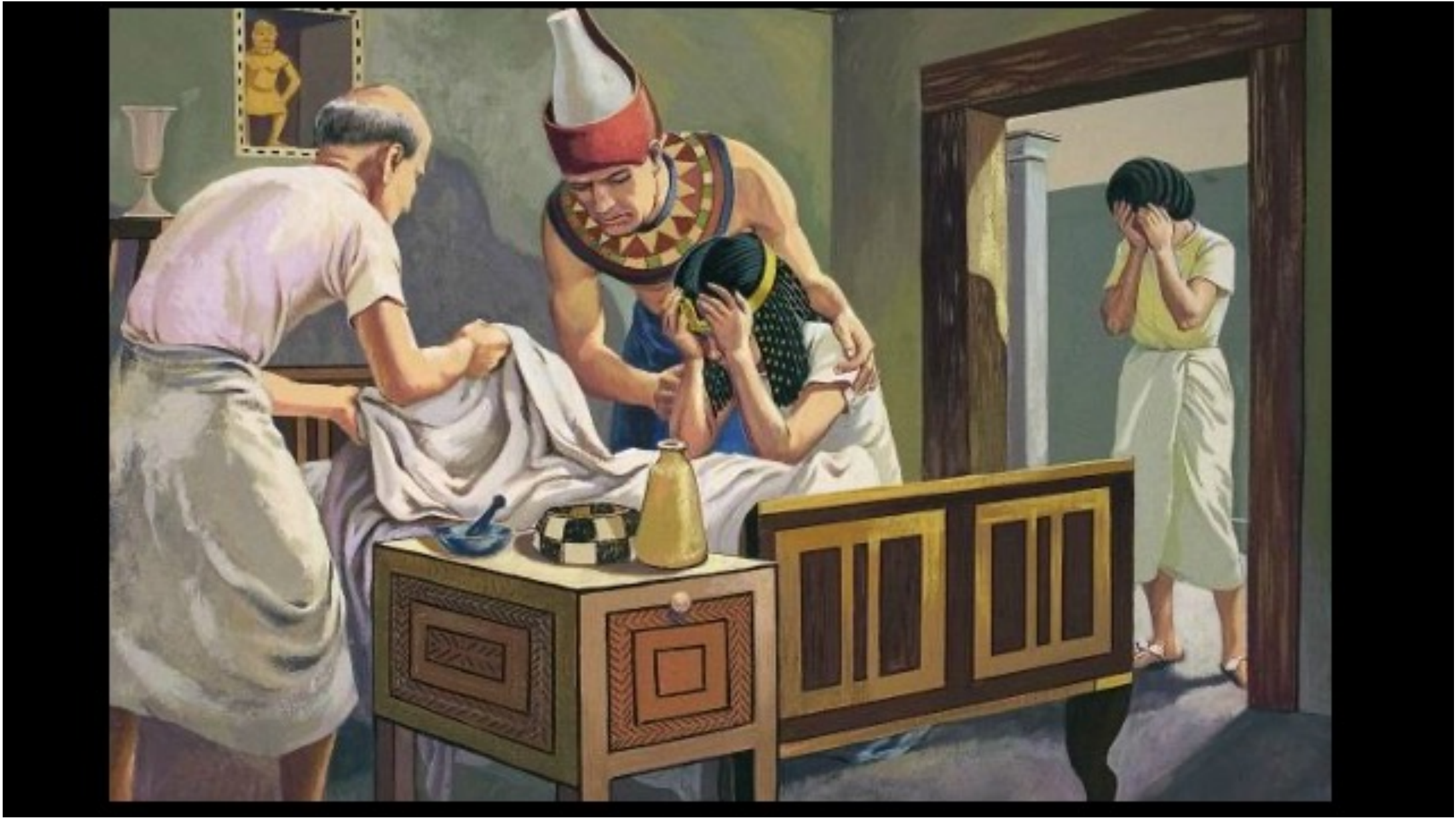

Numbers 9:2 Let the people of Israel

Numbers 9:13 But if anyone who is clean and is not on a journey **fails to keep** the Passover, that person shall be **cut off from his people...**

Numbers 9:17–23

[17] And whenever the **cloud lifted** from over the tent, after that the people of **Israel set out**, and in the place where the **cloud settled down**, there the **people of Israel camped**.



Numbers 9:17–23

[18] At the **command** of the LORD
the people of **Israel set out**,
and at the **command** of the LORD they **camped**.
As long as the **cloud rested** over the tabernacle,
they **remained in camp**.



Numbers 9:17–23

[19] Even when the **cloud continued** over the tabernacle many days, the people of Israel kept the charge of the LORD and **did not set out**.



Numbers 9:17–23

[20] Sometimes the **cloud** was a few days over the tabernacle, and according to the **command** of the LORD they **remained** in camp; then according to the **command** of the LORD they **set out**.



Numbers 9:17–23

[23] At the **command of the LORD** they camped, and at the **command of the LORD** they set out. They kept the charge of the LORD, **at the command of the LORD** by Moses.







NUMBERS 10: 1-10

Numbers 10:2

Make two silver trumpets. Of hammered work you shall make them, and you shall use them for **summoning the congregation and for breaking camp.**



Numbers 10:5

When you **blow an alarm**, the camps that are on the east side shall **set out**.

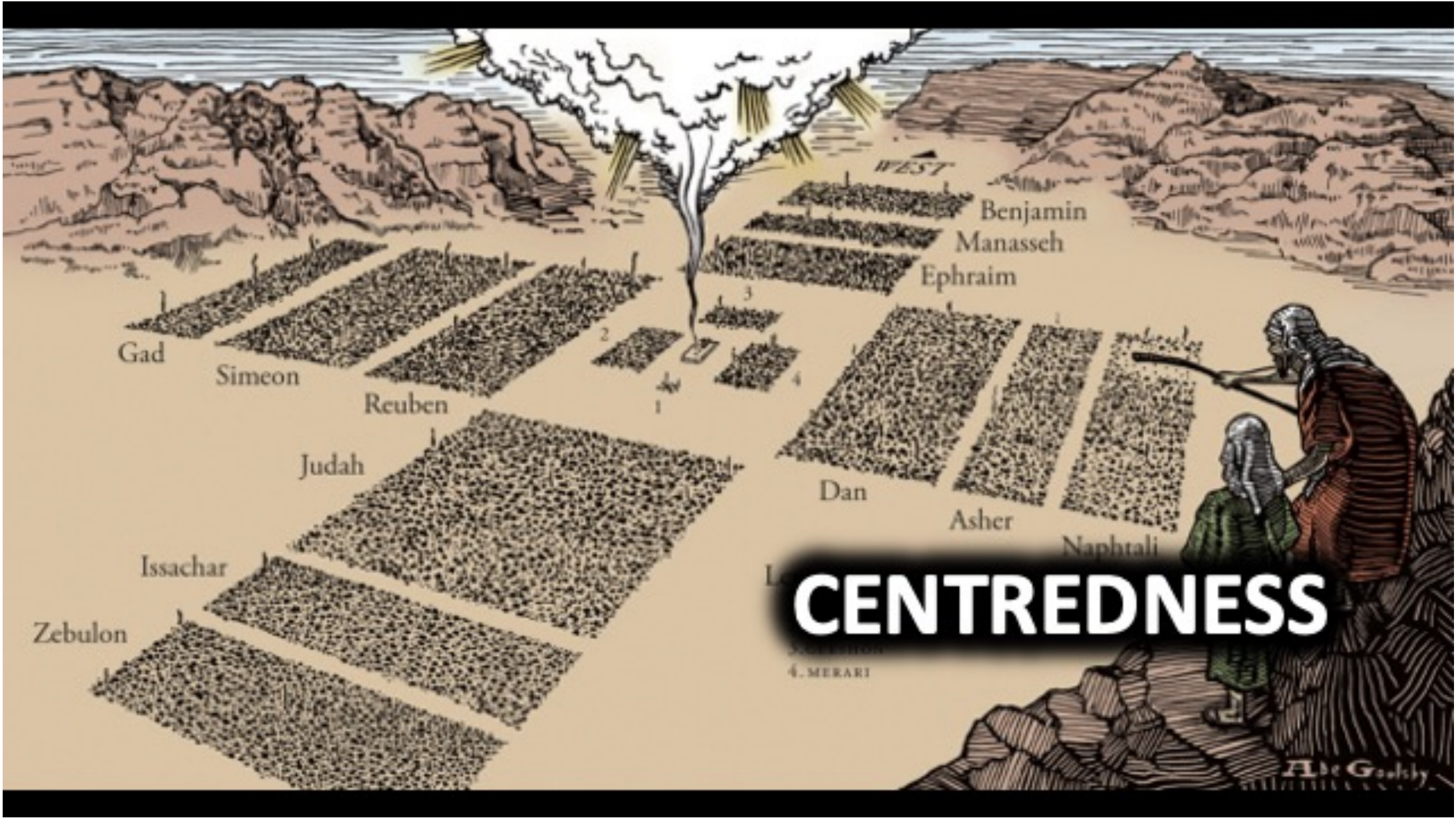
