

Jesus Christ is our final word

Jesus Christ is a familiar name for most people. For some, they relate to Jesus as the cute baby in the cradle portrayed during the

Christmas season. For others, Jesus is the wise teacher/prophet of the bible who teaches moral truths. But, for Christians, we acknowledge Jesus as our friend, saviour, our master and our Lord.

In the Book of John, Jesus was also depicted as the word (John 1:14). What does it mean to us in this present age? From Apostle John's perspective, we can understand this verse in relation to his experience: because John has journeyed with Jesus as His disciple; witnessing countless miracles performed by His master; saw the transfiguration of Jesus (Luke 9:28-30) and even witness the death of Jesus on the cross and His eventual resurrection. So, how can we, who are living in this present age, relate to this verse?

1. Jesus As The Word

Just as words are used to communicate, Jesus is God's ultimate message to humanity. In the days of the Old Testament, God communicated with His people via prophets, but now, He communicates with us through His son, Jesus. This message is that Jesus is the only son of God, who has paid in full the penalty of sin, and whosoever believes in Him, shall not perish, but will have everlasting life.

2. Jesus As Our Glory

Man innately seeks after glory; that is, a deeper meaning of life that satisfies his soul. After the fall of Adam (where sin came into the world), nothing else can ever satisfy man completely; not even the greatest wealth that one can ever earn in his lifetime, nor the immense power one can ever imagine wielding; nor the transient pleasures that satisfy our flesh. It is only by putting Jesus as our greatest treasure that our hearts can fully be satisfied in the glory that God so graciously bestowed upon us.

3. Jesus as Grace and Truth

Jesus embodies both grace and truth perfectly. He is the only righteous man who ever walked the earth, and He extends grace freely to all who humble themselves and follow Him. His truth exposes our need for Him, while His grace meets us in our brokenness. Jesus invites us to exchange our burdens for His light yoke (Matthew 11:28-30) and promises to enable us to live fruitful lives if we abide in Him through His Word (John 15:5).

Therefore, as the year 2024 ends off, let me invite you to consider a few questions:

- Do you treasure Jesus in your daily life or is your fulfilment coming from another source?
- Is there someone, you are withholding grace from, or should you be extending more grace to?

Even in the midst of hardships and trials, we can trust in Jesus to sustain us on this journey of faith toward the celestial city of God.

For those who have not yet come to know Jesus, I encourage you to pause and reflect on this truth: God sent His only Son, Jesus, as the final Word. In Jesus alone, you will find truth, grace, joy, peace, and glory. But this gift of eternal life requires a response. Repent of your sins, turn to Jesus, and embrace Him as your Lord and Savior. Only then will you discover the abundant and eternal life that He offers.




