The Greatest Threat To The Church

What is the greatest threat to the church today? Some might say, "wokeism, materialism, or immorality." Others might

say, "an indifference toward the gospel, adopting false doctrine, or a focus on selfhelp." Although these are certainly significant issues that can harm the church and hinder its progress, I am not sure they rise to the level of being the most significant threats.

Probably the greatest danger in the church today is the curse of lukewarmness. It is

what I call "ho-hum Christianity." It is as if we were yawning in the face of God. There is no fire, zeal, passion, or enthusiasm for the things of God. The resulting tragedy is a halfhearted church in a hell-bent world.

Jesus spoke prophetically of this half-hearted church when He said:

"And to the angel of the church in Laodicea write:

'I know your works: you are neither cold nor hot. Would that you were either cold or hot! So, because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of my mouth''' (Rev. 3:14-16).

The sin of lukewarmness is so nauseating to

the Lord that He wants to vomit the lukewarm church out of His mouth.

The Bible expositor G. Campbell Morgan said, "Lukewarmness is the worst form of blasphemy." Lukewarm Christians say, "Jesus, I believe in You, but You just don't excite me. I believe in You, but I don't intend to serve You with fire and fervor." A lukewarm church honors the Lord with its lips, but its heart is far from Him (Mark 7:6). Its members might not regularly participate in sin, but they tolerate it. They agree with the Scripture but rarely read it. They know prayer is important but seldom pray. They understand that Christianity calls for sacrifice and sharing the gospel, but it never happens.

The reason lukewarmness is so harmful is

that it sets us up for other sins. The lukewarm Christian is a sitting duck for the flesh, the devil, and the world. When Jesus no longer excites us, we soon drift away from the Lord and find other things to take His place. Lukewarmness is the root that breeds the fruit of all other sins. When we lose our fire, zeal, and passion for the Lord, we lose our Scriptural discernment and let go of our spiritual disciplines. We start to question the principles, practices, and power of the Christian life. That is why the Lord warned the lukewarm church:

"Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline, so be zealous and repent" (Rev. 3:19).

God loves us and wants to change the world through us. He encourages us to repent of our lukewarmness and warns that if we don't, He will reprove and discipline us. There is no greater way to protect the church and promote the cause of Christ than by being part of a church with a passionate love for the Lord.

Ask yourself: "Do I love the Lord my God with all my heart?" If not, repent.


