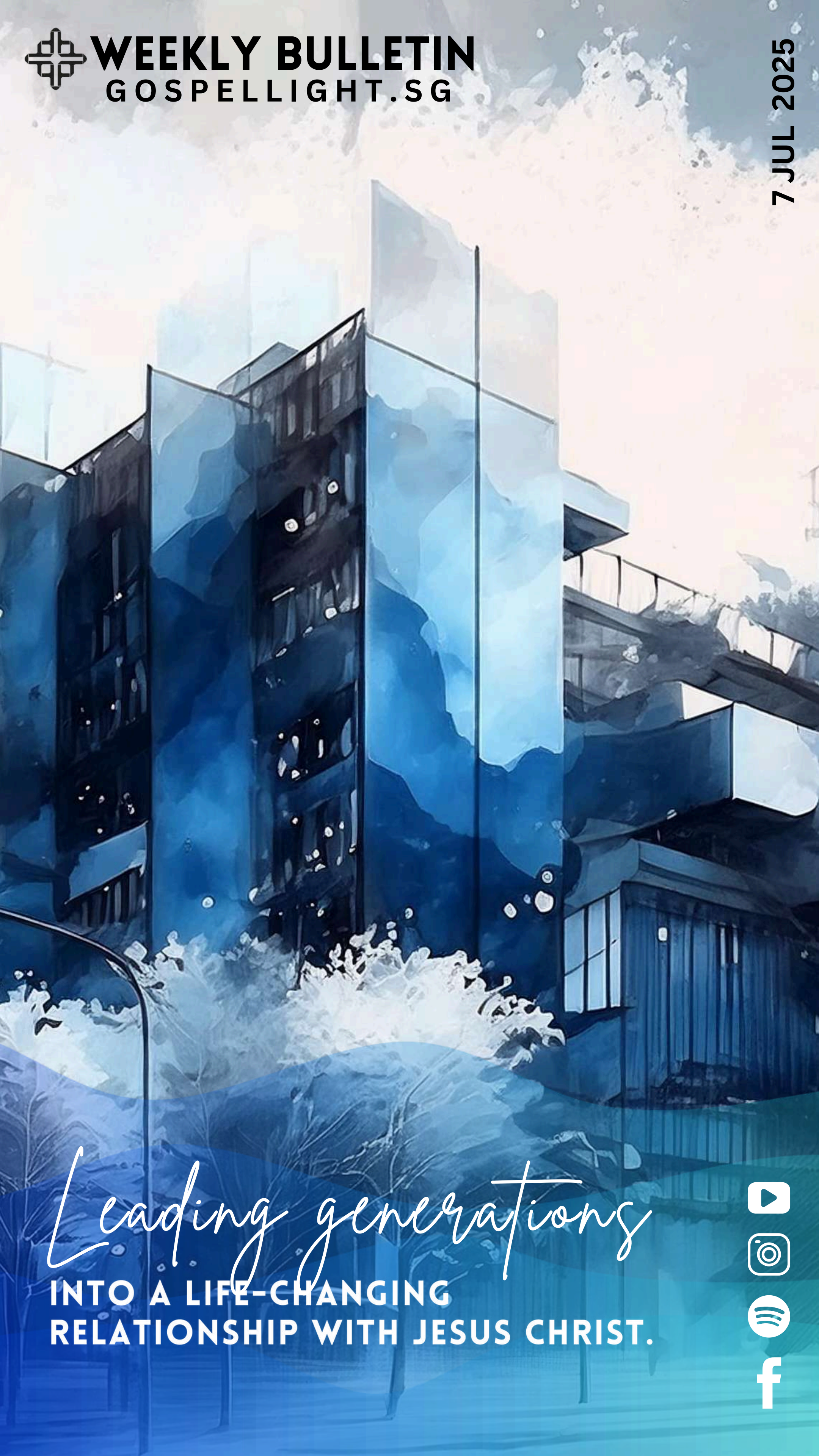

End Times and Everyday Faith

One of the most important but neglected subjects in the teaching ministry of the church and the life of the believer is the study of end times. To many, future events are complex, confusing, and often bring about disheartening disagreements. As a result, they see the study of end times as unnecessary or irrelevant to their daily walk with the Lord. But the study of eschatology is important and should be taken seriously.

The Bible Emphasizes the Future

The fact that so much of Scripture deals with the future tells us that it is a significant part of God's revelation. End times is a major part of the Bible's storyline—God's story includes past, present, and future events. We cannot have a proper Christian worldview if we neglect the study of the rapture, the tribulation, the second coming of Christ, the millennium, heaven, hell, and the New Heaven and New Earth.

Unfulfilled Prophecy Points to a Bigger Picture

There are large portions of Scripture that are yet to be fulfilled, such as Ezekiel 36–48, Matthew 24–25, 1 Thessalonians 4–5, 2 Thessalonians 1–2, 2 Peter 3, and Revelation 6–22, to name a few. If we ignore these passages and fail to understand what the Bible says about the future, we fail to grasp God's entire plan. When the church does not teach what Scripture says about the future, the whole counsel of God is not being taught

—and the church will lack motivation and purpose.

A Proper Understanding Changes How We Live

Understanding end times reshapes how we live, how we serve, and how we use our time, talents, and treasures. When we realise that we will one day stand before Jesus Christ and give an account of how we have lived the life He has loaned to us, it motivates us to live for Him with greater intentionality.

Eschatology Transforms and Purifies Us

Eschatology is not merely about charts and timelines—it is meant to transform us, purify us, and inspire us to live holy lives. The apostle John reminds us of this hope:

“Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is. And everyone who has this hope in Him purifies himself, just as He is pure.” (1 John 3:2–3)

Hope in the Midst of Suffering

To believers, the study of end times offers profound hope. Though this fallen world is filled with pain and heartache, Christians know how the story ends—a story of resurrection, renewal, and glory. As Paul says, “For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.” (Romans 8:18)

A Warning That Compels Us to Evangelize

Knowing what the Bible says about the end also reminds us that God's story doesn't end well for everyone. It serves as a warning that eternal punishment awaits those who do not repent and place their faith in Jesus Christ as Savior. This truth should move believers to be persistent in praying for, pursuing, and proclaiming the gospel to the lost.

Conclusion: Eschatology Fuels Urgency and Mission

Biblical eschatology is vital. It motivates the believer to live for the Lord. It warns the unbeliever to flee to the Lord. It provides a picture of how God's story concludes—a story that calls us to urgency, holiness, and gospel-centered mission. Let us study it, live in light of it, and share its truths with others.

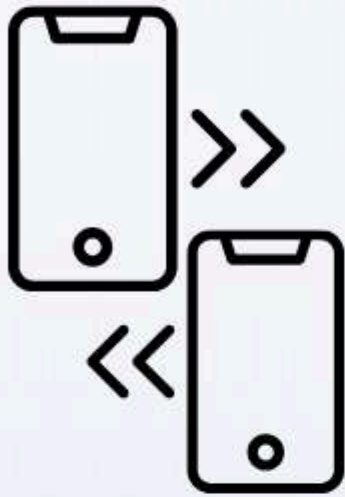
