Fromme Mountain - Brief History

It's not hard to imagine what Fromme Mountain would have looked like in 1880 before the first wave of settlers. A grove and virgin forest covered on these steep slopes with Douglas fir, Grand fir, and Red and Yellow Cedar and Western Hemlock trees in abundance. Trees that were perfect for the spars and timbers used by British, Canadian and American log-builders. Enjoy your hike or your mountain bike ride and have the forest as you find it. It's still recovering from the devastation that began at the end of the 19th century.

Justice Vincent Hoong said Lin's acts of inflicting violence on animals for his perverse pleasure were **among the most heinous cases of animal cruelty** to come before the courts.

The judge said his decision sends a clear message: "Animal cruelty has no place in a just and humane society and will be met with the full force of the law."

He said that given the continued prevalence – and potential increase – of animal cruelty and welfare cases, the courts must give greater weight to **deterrence in sentencing.**
