





He could not erase or alter it once written —

if a mistake was made, the entire parchment might have to be discarded.

Early Christians did not pronounce YHWH but said *Lord* instead.







#### 3. Reformation & Protestant Bibles


Many translators (16th–17th century) adopted LORD (all caps) to indicate .יהוה





## 4. Modern Christianity

Most Christian traditions today: Use LORD in translations (e.g., NIV, ESV).



























































