Reawakening Our Hearts to God's Beauty

Burnout can happen to anyone, including believers. It happens when we run too hard. Our Lord diagnosed Martha as “distracted with much serving.” In the very presence of Jesus, she became “anxious and troubled about many things” (Luke 10:38–42). If we keep running too hard for too long, we become spiritually dull. The warning signs appear when you regularly feel overwhelmed, weary, or emotionally flat. The prolonged intensity of life’s noise, speed, or

sorrows can cause a numbness in our souls and dull our senses to God's presence.

When We Try to Outrun the Numbness

The strange thing is that, when this happens, we often run even harder or faster in life. We seek more activities to distract us. We scour the internet for more information to find a cure. We look for more entertainment to soothe our tired and troubled hearts. While these may stimulate or console us for a while, they rarely satisfy the deeper cry of the soul. In such times we need to awaken to the call to draw near to God. Only in the presence of the beauty of the Lord (Psalm 27:4) can our souls find true security and satisfaction.

Paul: A Tireless Servant Who Flourished

Consider someone who ran harder and longer than almost anyone since the birth of the New Testament church. If anyone could burn out—or want out—the apostle Paul would be a prime candidate. He worked tirelessly to spread the gospel, plant churches, and minister to believers, yet suffered all kinds of persecutions and setbacks. Instead of ending like a dried-up prune, he flourished continually like a fruitful vine in the house of the Lord. What was the secret spring in his heart? How did he keep his soul from becoming a dry and parched land?

Paul's “One Thing”

Up to the end of his life, Paul said, “Brothers, I do not consider that I have made it my own. But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on...” (Philippians 3:13–14). What is this “one thing”? He explains: “I count everything as loss because of the

surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord” (v. 8); “that I may gain Christ” (v. 9); and “that I may know him” (v. 10). Paul strove to know Christ all his life. He was continually awakened to the beauty and power of Christ as he gazed upon Him.

Counting Every Gain as Loss

Paul learned not to take pride in achievements of the flesh—his own strength. Even his attainments in the Law he counted as rubbish for the sake of gaining Christ. At this point in his life, he also did not parade his achievements as a servant of Jesus Christ. All the wonderful activities and amazing experiences—as accomplished apostle, faithful preacher, loving pastor, courageous missionary—were not on his mind. Only Jesus, and knowing Him, mattered in Paul’s heart.

A Call to Refocus on Christ

If you are feeling spiritually numb or distant from God, it is not because Christ is not powerful, beautiful, or sufficient. It is

because we need to take time to focus, as Paul did, and ask: What should matter to me today? What should I be striving after? What should be my goal in life? What is the “one thing” for me? Take time; slow down; gaze upon the beauty and power of Jesus in the Scriptures, “until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts” (2 Peter 1:19). When your soul is awakened once again to the beauty and glory of God in Christ, it will be the beginning of a better day in your walk with Him.

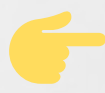

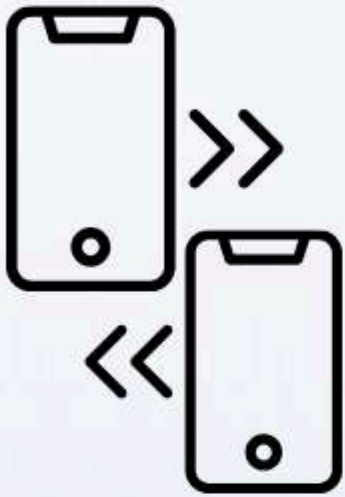
