Different Shoes, Different Seasons

Imagine someone gifting you store credit at your favourite shoe store. The credit is fully paid for, but here's the catch: you still need to go to the store, pick a pair, and claim it.

Shopping for the Perfect Shoe

Shopping for the perfect pair of shoes is like finding a ministry to serve in—it's rarely easy. I usually need to try several pairs before discovering one that fits well and feels right. In the same way, discovering the right

ministry often requires stepping out and trying different roles.

My First Pair of Shoes

My first “shoe” was as a Shepherd in the Children’s Ministry—that’s the fancy title for carrying toddlers to the bathroom and helping them pay attention to the Bible teacher. Despite the simple tasks, I struggled at times—some toddlers were heavier than I expected!—but God sustained me in the small things and gave me the opportunity to serve alongside others.

Breaking into a New Pair of Shoes

After a few years, I stepped into Small Group Leader shoes—no longer just caring for toddlers, but leading Bible discussions with primary school kids. I was nervous: tough questions, no kids of my own, shallow Bible knowledge as a new believer. Yet God walked with me, and the stiff shoes softened. He used the role to grow their faith—and mine.

Different Shoes for Different Seasons

Just as sandals suit summer and boots suit winter, God may call us to different ministries in different seasons. After six years as an SGL, I was nudged into another pair of shoes—the role of Big Group Teacher (BGT). My first response was, “No way!” Teaching a hundred kids at once? Could I really handle God’s Word faithfully? These shoes felt far too big for me. Yet with the encouragement of my church family, I stepped in, trusting that the God who calls also equips.

Shoes Are for Walking

The value of a shoe isn’t in owning it, but in the walking it enables. Through various roles, I’ve been blessed to share the gospel, witness faith grow, learn Scripture more deeply through teaching, and grow alongside other believers.

I’ll never forget meeting two kids I’d mentored years earlier. As children they

didn't believe, but the bond we built let them—now teens—open up about their struggles. One even encouraged the other, who'd stopped attending, to return to church. It reminded me: we may not see fruit immediately; our call is faithfulness—God brings the change.

Looking back, every “pair of shoes” I've worn has helped me grow in faith and taught me to depend on God's strength.

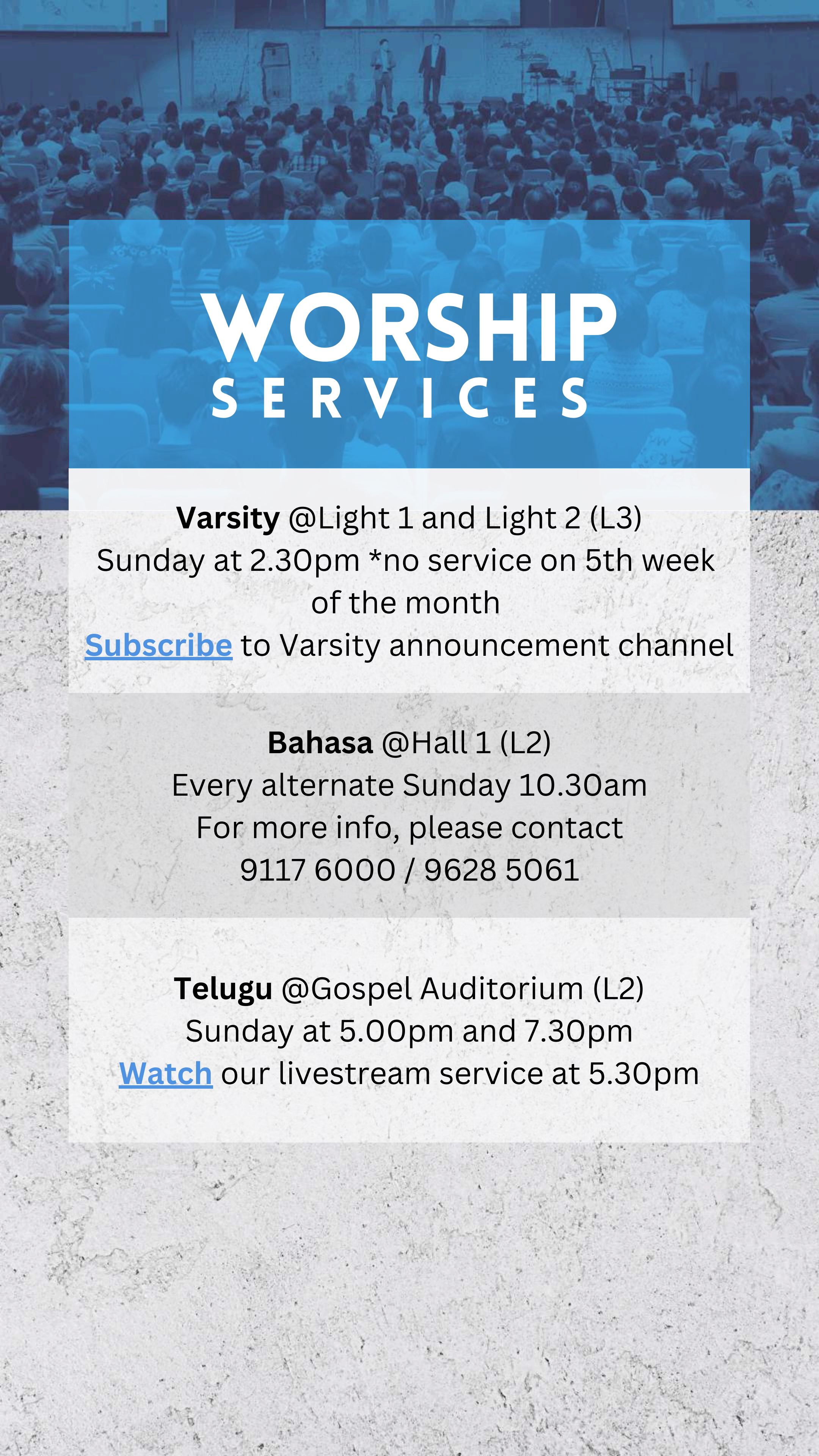

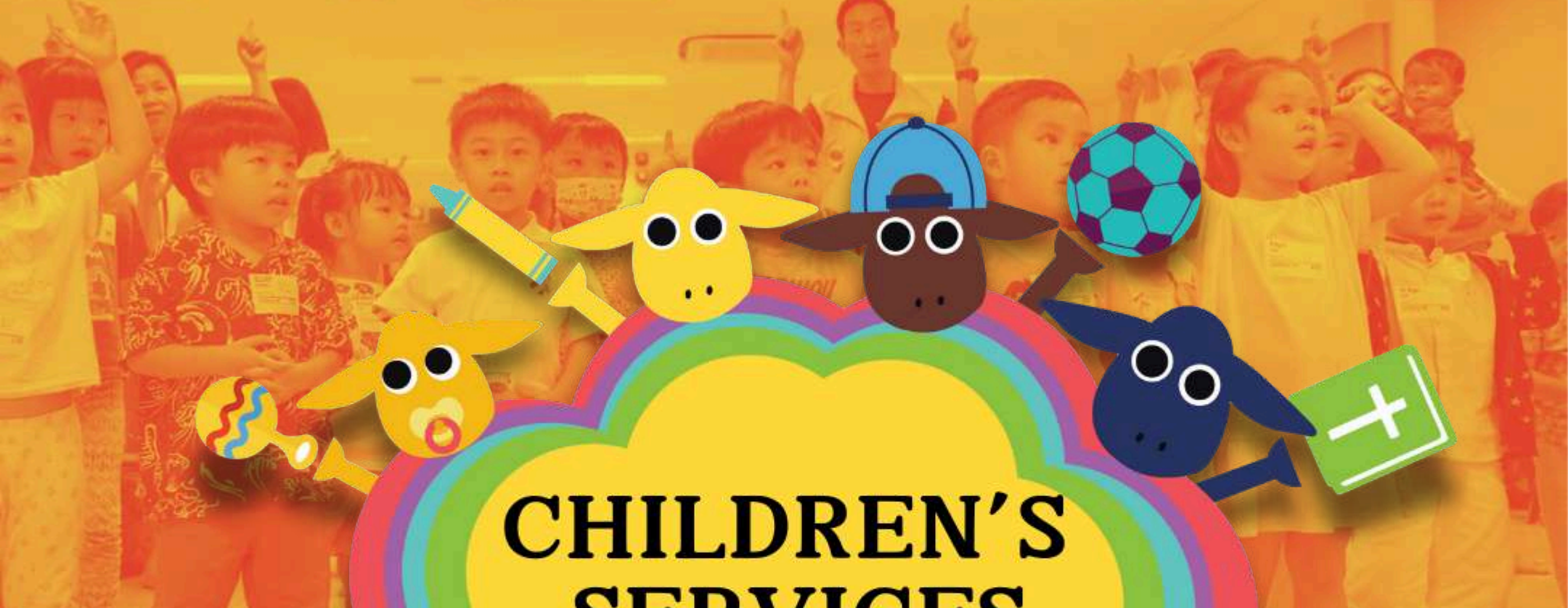

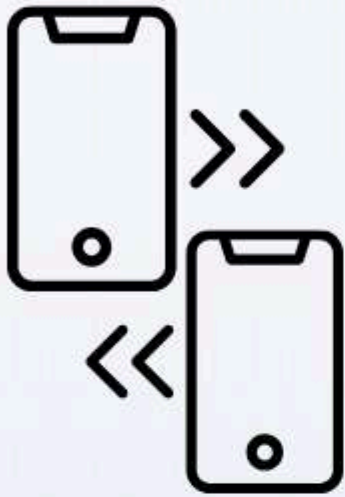
