THE SYMBOLIC MEANING OF THE 3 GIFTS OF THE MAGI



GOLD

The gold represents Christ's kingship; He is the King of the Jews and Lord of lords



FRANKINCENSE

a sweet-smelling resin used in worship; it symbolises his priesthood and divinity



MYRRH

an ointment used in burial, myrrh represented His humanity, death, and burial




