The Quiet Killer in My Heart

In John 2:16, it is written that “for all that is in the world, the desires of the flesh and the desires of the eyes and pride of life, is not from the Father but is from the world.” So, what exactly is this pride of life that is of the world? Most people can relate to the common wisdom that pride can bring forth destruction (Proverbs 16:18), but beyond this understanding of pride, are there deeper layers of pride that are subtle that may trip the lives of Christians?

Why Pride Is Such a Big Deal

God hates prideful people. In the gospel of Matthew, Jesus gave clear indications on how the Pharisees pray and fast in public places so as to “boast” of their outward devotion to God; where in fact; their hearts were far away from Him. In the parable of the pharisee and tax collector (Luke 18:9-14), Jesus exposes the pride of the pharisee who exalts himself over the tax collector, and even looks down on the tax collector as a sinner. Paradoxically, Jesus indicates that at the end of the day, it is the tax collector who came away justified before God.

What Pride Actually Is (and Isn't)

These examples show that God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble, and He is against a heart that despises others in “superiority.” This doesn't mean God is against greatness, power, or wealth. Scripture includes godly men like Joseph, Daniel, and David but when achievements

become self-glory, God can humble us, as He did King Nebuchadnezzar in Daniel 4.

How Pride Hides in Everyday Life

Therefore, let us be mindful of hidden pride that feeds our ego. Like any sin, we must be quick to face prideful thoughts and fight them decisively. What has helped me is this: when I achieve something or receive praise, I try to give thanks immediately to God, the Giver, and resist any “self” glory. I also seek to redirect praise toward God, so that others may see the good works and give glory to our Father in heaven (Matt 5:16). And I take time to consider and pray about how best to steward achievements—power, wealth, or

position—for the good of others and the advance of God’s kingdom. How we use these gifts reveals our heart: whether we bless and build up others and the church, or indulge the flesh. In this sense, they test us - whether our true treasure is God Himself or earthly riches that will one day rust and rot.

Jesus: The Humble King

And when we fail the test and fall into the sin of pride, remember then we have a great high priest, Jesus Christ, who is constantly interceding for us. Repent of our pride, ask for His forgiveness, and trust that God is faithful and just, and will cleanse us of all unrighteousness (1John 1:9).

Practicing Repentance and Growing in Humility

Brothers and sisters, we have been set free from sin - including pride and by holding fast to God’s Word we can walk by the Spirit. Remember Christ’s humility: He emptied Himself, took the form of a servant, and

humbled Himself to death on a cross (Phil. 2:7–8). And if you do not yet believe, pride may be your stumbling block. So come humbly like the tax collector: “God, be merciful to me, a sinner!” Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.



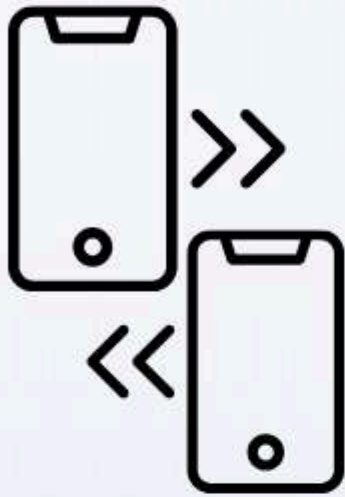
