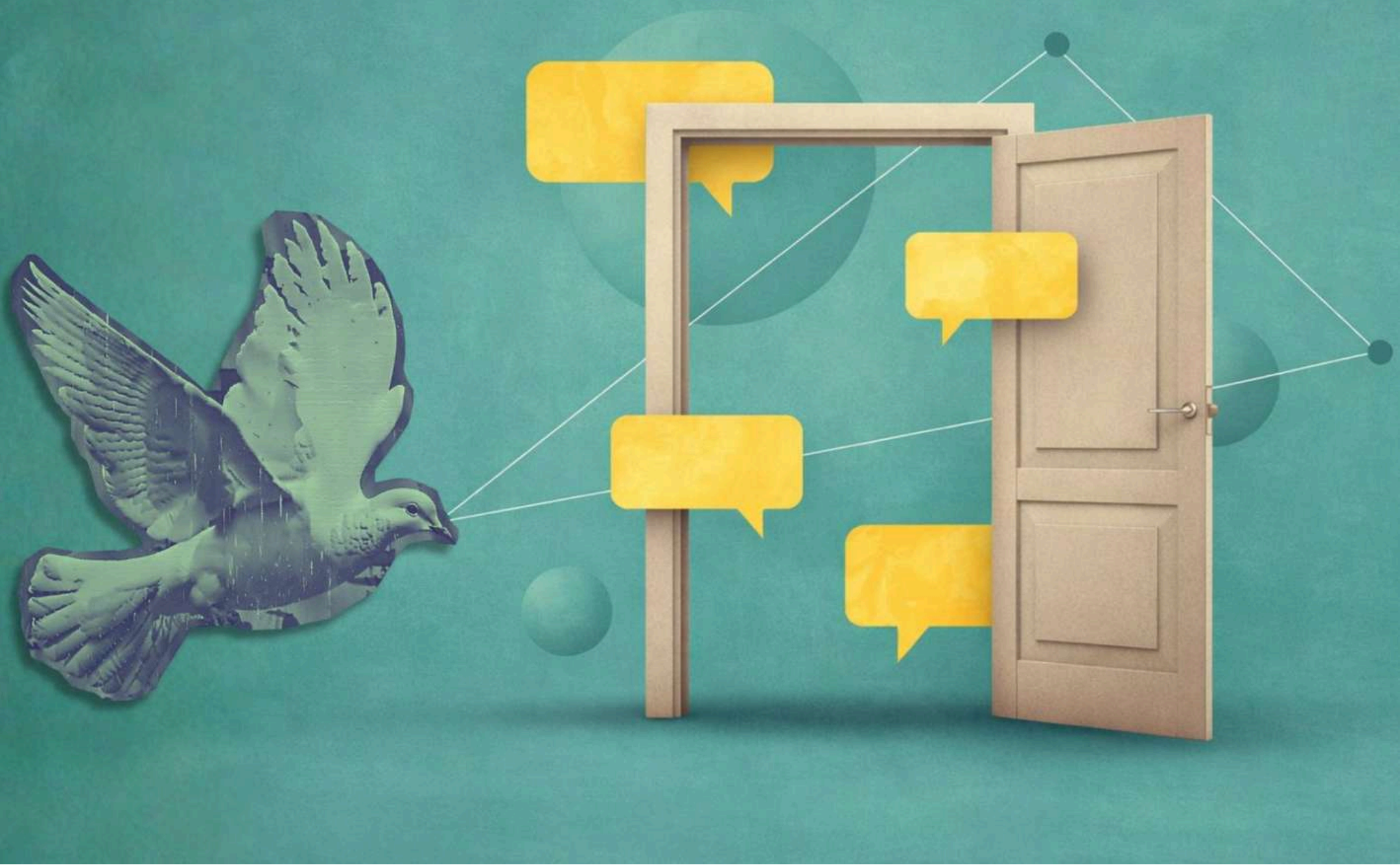

Not by Might: The Spirit in Evangelism

Many today shudder at the thought of evangelism. We picture street preaching, cold theological debates, or bold public declarations in packed halls. We quietly assume that kind of courage belongs to someone else. Someone more gifted. More confident. More “spiritual.” But when Jesus spoke about witness in Acts 1:8, He had a very different picture in mind.

Power for Witness

“You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses...” (Acts 1:8). Notice what Jesus promised. He did not promise the disciples foolproof arguments or unbridled confidence. He promised power—the enabling presence of the Holy Spirit—so that ordinary people can live and speak for Christ wherever God places them.

Ordinary People, Extraordinary Calling

This is evident in the lives of the disciples. They were not extraordinary by human standards. They were fishermen, tax

collectors, and everyday men who had recently failed Jesus at His darkest hour. They were still asking questions, still afraid, still unsure of what lay ahead. Yet Jesus did not delay His mission until they felt ready. Instead, He told them to wait for the Spirit. The power for witness would not come from within them; it would come from God.

Boldness Birthed in Prayer

Acts 4 shows us what this power looks like in real life. After Peter and John are threatened by religious authorities and ordered to stop speaking about Jesus, the church gathers to pray. Their prayer is striking. They do not ask for safety. They do not ask for influence or comfort. They ask for boldness (Acts 4:29).

“And when they had prayed, the place in which they were gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and continued to speak the word of God with boldness” (Acts 4:31).

That’s courage born from trust. The early

believers knew their own limitations, so they leaned into prayer. They knew that obedience would be costly, yet they trusted the Spirit to sustain them. Their boldness was not loud or arrogant; it was quiet faithfulness in the face of real opposition.

What Ordinary Evangelism Looks Like

That same Spirit empowers believers today. Ordinary evangelism rarely looks dramatic. It looks like honest conversations with a friend who is struggling. It looks like integrity at work, kindness in conflict, patience when it would be easier to remain silent or self-protective. It looks like being willing to name Jesus naturally—without shame, but also without pressure—when opportunities arise.

Courage Beyond Personality

Evangelism is daunting. But it is not about saying everything perfectly; it is about pointing sinners to the Savior. The Spirit does not remove our personalities or fears

overnight, but He gives courage to act despite them. Sometimes that courage is a single sentence spoken in love. Sometimes it is the humility to listen well. Sometimes it is facing and answering tough questions when it would be easier to withdraw. Acts reminds us that the church does not grow by human strength alone. God delights in using ordinary people who depend on extraordinary power.

A Simple Prayer for Faithful Witness

And so, when gospel opportunities arise—when a question is asked, a door opens, or the spotlight unexpectedly falls on us—may we not shrink back in fear. The same Spirit who filled the early church is at work today. In those ordinary, unscripted moments, may we rely on His power and proclaim Christ with quiet courage and humble boldness, trusting that God delights to work through faithful witnesses who step forward when it matters most.



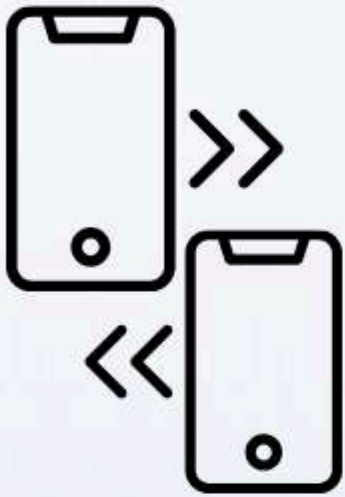
