## Compelling Gospel Community

In today's world of fleeting connections, you may have convinced yourself there is little value in being part of just another group. After all, you may have other social circles and a few Christian friends you already keep up with, so why bother?

I used to think the same way. In fact, it took me two years before I committed to a care group. Along the way, I learned something remarkable: care groups are meant to be

supernatural communities that reveal the gospel.

## **Care Groups Reveal the Gospel**

In Ephesians 2–3, Paul reminds us of God’s plan for the local church, beginning with the gospel: we were once “dead in transgressions and sins” (Eph. 2:1), but God “made us alive with Christ” (Eph. 2:5). In the gospel, God pours out supernatural forgiveness on his people.

## **The Gospel Creates Supernatural Unity**

But the gospel goes beyond individual salvation; it also creates a new people. In Ephesians 2, Paul describes God breaking down the wall of hostility between Jews and Gentiles, creating “one new man” in place of the two, and reconciling us to himself.

This unity has a purpose: Ephesians 3:10 tells us that through the church, God displays his manifold wisdom to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places. God’s

church, and by extension, our care groups—are designed to showcase supernatural gospel unity to a watching world.

## **The Gospel Produces Supernatural Love**

So what does this mean for us? As Christians who have received Christ's forgiveness, our response is clear: to love God and to love one another. The gospel frees us to embrace one another despite our differences. As Scripture reminds us, "We love because he first loved us" (1 John 4:19).

The gospel also moves us beyond the superficial, enabling us to love deeply and sacrificially. We can rejoice with those who rejoice and weep with those who weep—even when their season highlights our own struggles. We can walk with a brother or sister through grief, doubts, or a hard season of obedience. Gospel-driven love emboldens us to speak truth with grace, extend mercy to the weary, and support those in need within our community.

And when we find it hard to love, we return again to the gospel and remember the forgiveness we share in Christ. We love one another not by sheer willpower, but through the Spirit God has given us.






