Looking to Jesus Again

In the busyness of church life, work, family, and ministry, it is possible to stay active in many good things while slowly losing sight of the One who matters most. We may speak often about serving Jesus, learning from Jesus, and living for Jesus, but every now and then, we need to pause and return to a simple, searching question: **Who is Jesus to us?**

When Jesus asked His disciples, “But who do you say that I am?”, He was not asking for information. He was calling for faith. He wanted a personal response. That same question still

comes to us today, and how we answer it shapes the way we follow Him.

Jesus is fully God

The Bible shows us that Jesus is far more than a good teacher or inspiring example. He is fully God, worthy of our worship, trust, and surrender. This means that when we come to Him, we are not coming to someone weak or uncertain. We are coming to the Son of God, the One with all authority, power, and glory. He is able to save completely, lead wisely, and hold us securely.

Jesus is Fully Man

Yet the same Jesus is also fully man. He entered our world and shared in our human experience. He knew hunger, weariness, sorrow, and pain. He lived amid the ordinary pressures of life in a fallen world. This is deeply comforting for us. It means that Jesus is not distant from our struggles; He understands them. When we come to Him in our weakness, confusion, or grief, we come to One who truly knows what it is to live as a man, and yet without sin.

The Saviour We Need

Because Jesus is both fully God and fully man, He is exactly the Saviour we need. He alone can reveal God to us perfectly, and He alone can represent us fully before God. He is not merely a figure to admire from afar. He is the living Christ to whom we must look in faith and follow in every part of our lives.

Looking to Jesus Again

This is why looking to Jesus matters so much. We do not simply need more activity, more knowledge, or more effort. We need a fresh sight of Christ. We need to remember who He is and what He has done. The more clearly we see Him, the more deeply we will trust Him.

The Christian life is not sustained by duty alone.

It is strengthened by knowing Christ, loving Christ, and following Christ. May we not lose sight of Him in the midst of all our responsibilities. And as we look to Jesus again, may our hearts be renewed to follow Him more faithfully. Perhaps this is a good moment for each of us to slow down and ask: **Am I still looking to Jesus?**

Let us keep our eyes on Christ, for the more we see His glory, the better we will follow Him.

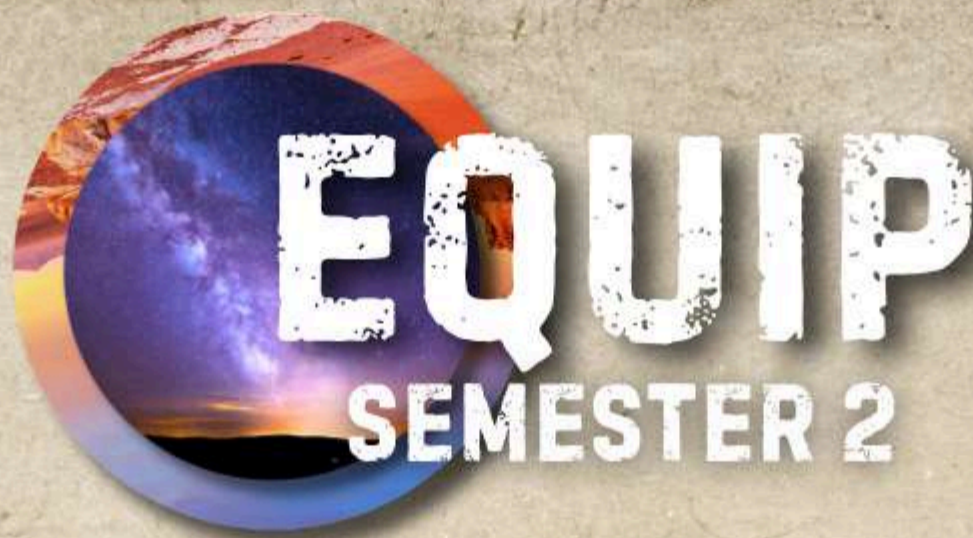

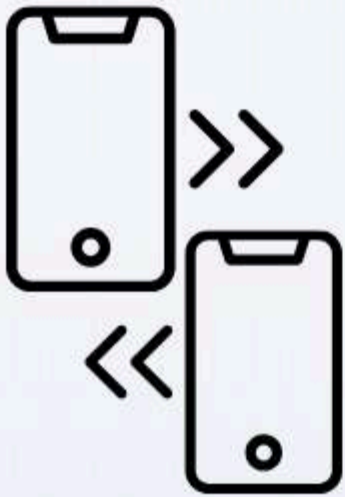

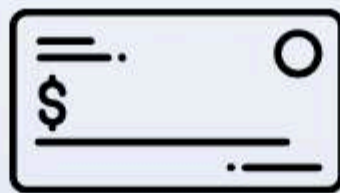
