Gospel in the Mirror

Mirror, mirror on the wall — when we see our reflections, “*How do I look?*” is never far behind. Mirrors help put us in order - straighten our ties, smooth a crease. The trouble comes when we make them more.

For some, the mirror becomes an accuser. We catalogue every imperfection — the breakout, the belly, the wrinkles — and shrink away, convinced we’re broken. For others, pride makes mirrors a gilded stage. We swell, quietly pleased when the light hits right.

Both are idolatry - letting appearance define our worth. Social media makes these “mirrors”

relentless: never quite right, always one filter away from better.

But what if our bodies reflect more than what is skin deep?

David says, "I praise ***you*** because I am fearfully and wonderfully made" (Psalm 139:14). He answers a different question. Not "How do I look?", but "Whose am I?"

Scripture's answer is breathtaking: we are God's. His Creation. His Image-bearer. His Sanctuary. Our bodies are not scorecards, they are windows revealing our Maker.

God's Creation

We live in an age that celebrates artisanal products, every detail telling a story of intention. Yet, we rarely see our bodies that way.

Psalm 139 tells us God knit us in our mothers' wombs. Not random genetics, but ***knit*** — a craftsman working slowly, deliberately, attentive to every stitch. He hasn't looked away since — even our hairs are numbered (Matt 10:30).

The part of you that you edit photos to hide. The body changed by puberty, motherhood, illness, age. God fashioned every version of us.

As a cancer patient, this is a familiar struggle. Some days, I yearn so desperately for my redeemed, eternal body that I resent the one I have now - seeing it as a blight, not a gift. I grieve the body I used to have, forgetting that she too was formed by the same Hands.

To despise what we see in the mirror isn't just unkind to ourselves. It's quietly telling the Most High He got it wrong. Every inch of us is His divine choice - and He makes no mistakes.

God's Image

Scripture tells us we aren't just His handiwork. We are His image-bearers.

To bear God's likeness is to carry something sacred in our flesh. Of all creation, only Man was made *imago Dei*. Not the mountains. Not the stars. Just you, and me.

We are portraits of God, mirrors designed to reflect His glory. The fall distorted this, turning us inward, transfixing us with our own reflections.

Shame and pride make our bodies about us. **We** become the point, when we were always meant to be the pointer.

We were never the subject of the portrait. He is.

God's Sanctuary

As believers, we were also bought at a price — not silver or gold, but the precious blood of Christ. That's why our bodies are now “a temple of the Holy Spirit” (1 Cor 6:19-20).

A temple is not ordinary space. It is set apart. Sacred. God's dwelling place. Precious in His sight, purposed for His glory.

That's what our bodies are.

The One who spoke the universe into existence
lives in us — scars, imperfections, and all.

So go ahead. Look in the mirror. Tidy your hair.
Straighten your collar.

But we mustn't stop there.

Refuse the lie that we're defective. Reject that
our worth fits in a frame. See ourselves as God
does — wonderfully made, dearly bought, deeply
loved. Behold the One we were made by, made
like, and made for.

Then our mirrors stop being a verdict - and
become a doxology.

A window. An altar. A place of praise.

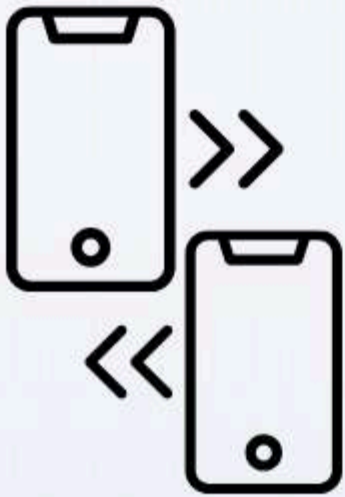

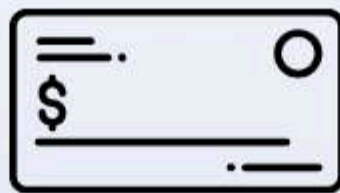
