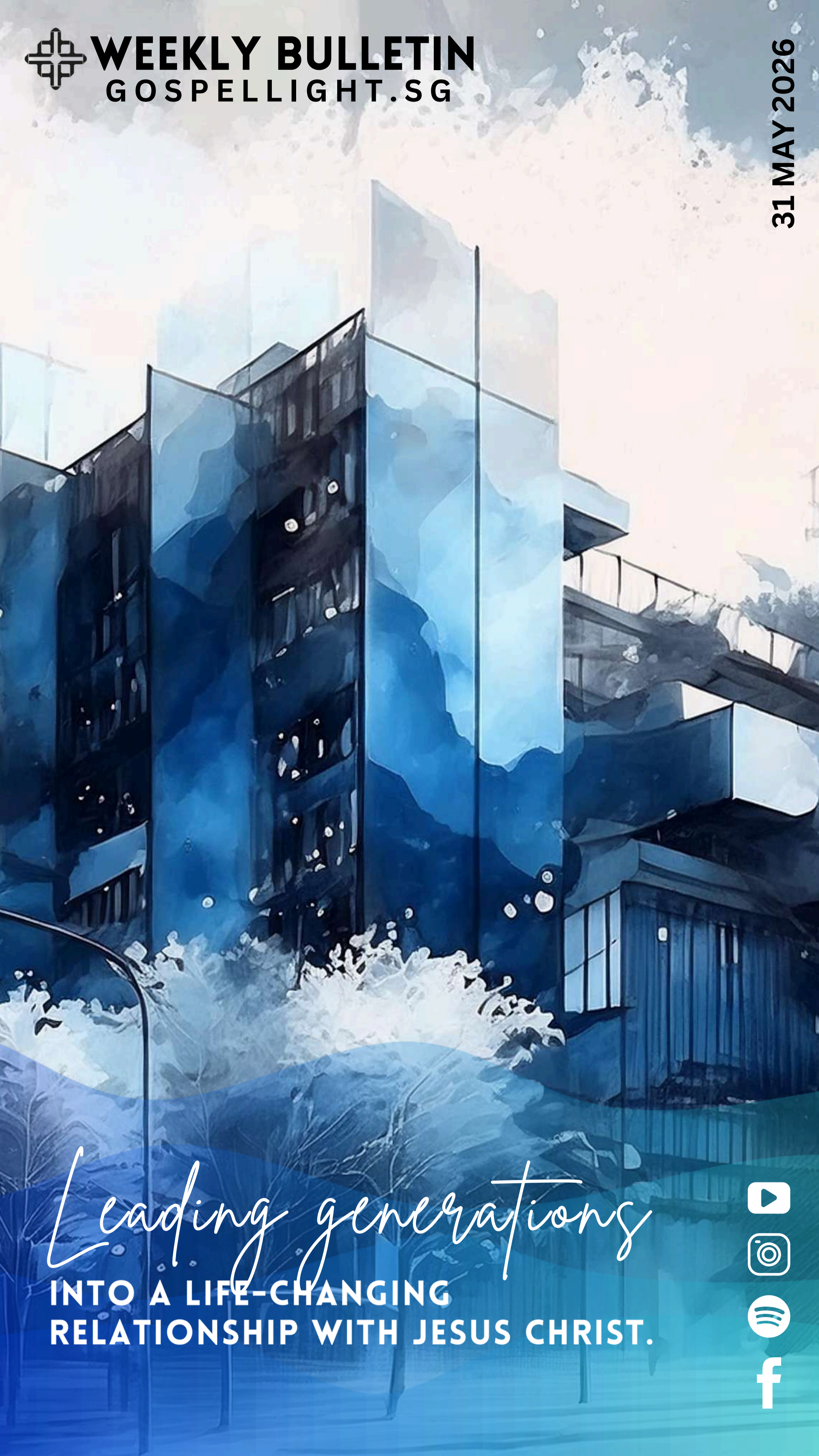

3 Reasons We Need to Understand Spiritual Warfare

When you hear “spiritual warfare,” what comes to mind? A dramatic clash with demons? Intense prayer? Or something less defined?

Some see spiritual warfare in everything: a bad day, a tough conversation, a moment of temptation. Others barely acknowledge it at all, explaining life's struggles purely in terms of stress, personality, or circumstances. The Bible, however, offers a more balanced view. Spiritual warfare is simply the reality of living in a fallen world where the world, the flesh, and the devil

oppose faith and obedience.

So why does it matter that we understand spiritual warfare rightly?

1. Because It Is a Daily Reality

Every believer is in a spiritual battle, whether we realise it or not. This battle rarely looks dramatic. More often, it shows up in ordinary moments: the pull toward pride, selfishness, lust, anger, anxiety, unforgiveness, or discontentment.

Scripture reminds us that our struggle is not merely human. At the same time, it cautions us against two extremes: denying spiritual realities (“it’s just circumstances”) or over-spiritualising everything (“there’s a demon behind it”).

Instead, we are called to sober awareness—recognising that evil is real, but not ultimate. God alone is sovereign, and He has already secured the victory.

Spiritual warfare, then, is a daily exercise of faith. It often looks unspectacular: choosing truth over lies, obedience over convenience, prayer over panic. Yet each small act of

faithfulness quietly declares that Jesus is Lord.

2. Because It Displays Christ’s Victory

Many believers grow discouraged in their struggles, especially when sin or weariness feels persistent. But a right understanding of spiritual warfare reframes the fight. The Christian life is not about trying to win a still-undecided battle—it is about living in light of a victory already won.

Through His death and resurrection, Christ has defeated the powers of darkness. That means every act of obedience is not just resistance—it is a display. When we resist temptation, forgive someone, choose contentment, or trust God in hardship, we are bearing witness to His triumph.

We fight not for victory, but from victory.

This truth guards us from despair. The struggle is real, but it is not final. Our hope does not rest

on how well we perform, but on what Christ has already accomplished.

3. Because It Drives Us to Rely on God

The Christian life is lived on a battlefield—but we are not left to fight alone. God equips His people through the ordinary means of grace: His Word, prayer, worship, and fellowship.

When we are tempted, we pray—entrusting ourselves to God, just as Jesus did. Prayer is not simply a way to get what we want; it is how we depend on God in the midst of the battle. As John Piper said, prayer is not an intercom to the butler, but a wartime walkie-talkie to call upon God in the battle for souls.

When we are weary or doubtful, we turn to Scripture and worship, reminding ourselves of God's character and promises. When we feel isolated, we lean into Christian community, recognising that we are meant to stand together, not alone.

Above all, we rely on the Holy Spirit, who strengthens, convicts, and leads us in obedience. Spiritual warfare is not about self-effort—it is

about dependence.

A Final Encouragement

The battle can be tiring, and there will be moments of weakness. But we are not left uncertain about the outcome. God faithfully keeps His people, and Christ has already secured the final victory.

So we press on—watchful, grounded, and steadfast. Not because we are strong, but because He is.

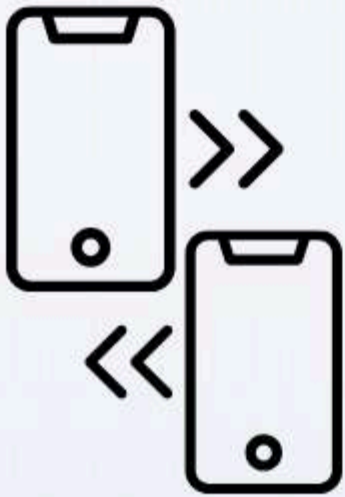

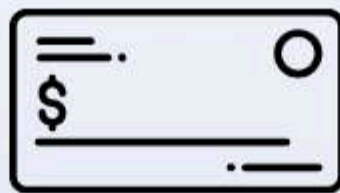
