When Serving God Exposes Our Need for God

Ministry burnout often brings us to the end of ourselves. It exposes the uncomfortable truth that we are limited, needy, and unable to carry the burdens of ministry in our own strength.

Burnout happens because you are human. Burnout happens because we're broken people, living in a broken world with other broken humans. And that means that in ministry, some burdens are too difficult to bear, some cases too hard to solve, and some seasons just suck the life out of us. Burnout happens because we are

limited humans who have limited capacity.

Let's normalize talking about burnout, let's not make burnout a taboo topic in church, Suffering from burnout doesn't make you less of a Christian, less of a spiritual leader or less of a person in God's eyes.

How then do we process our seasons of burnout? Joseph spoke in Genesis 50:20: *“As for you, you meant evil against me, but God meant it for good...”* Our all-powerful and sovereign God, can turn evil or bad situations for good. The pain and suffering experienced through burnout can work out for our good. Let's not waste our burnout.

1. Burnout reveals our spiritual insecurities and shortcomings

Often, burnout in ministry comes from deeply rooted issues inside us. The worries and pressures of ministry occupy our thoughts throughout the day and leave little room for anything else. This might be born out of a genuine concern for a hurting member or an ongoing CG conflict. Yet in some cases, they might reveal certain insecurities and

shortcomings in us. Burnout allows for spiritual introspection and reflection.



“What you fear the most reveals what you value the most and where you trust God the least.”



I came across this Craig Groeschel quote years ago, and it has stayed with me ever since. “What you fear the most reveals what you value the most and where you trust God the least”. It’s helped me process my seasons of burnout. It showed me my spiritual shortcomings and my lack of trust. It’s allowed burnout to be my classroom. It’s ensured that I don’t make the same mistake again. It makes sure that I grow from my lessons! Burnout is painful; don’t waste it.

2. Burnout reveals our limitations and our need for Jesus

Burnouts are humbling, because you come face-to-face with a reality that you don’t like: You can’t do it all. Everyone is trying to do more and

more, to be more productive than everyone else. Nobody likes to be told that they can't do it. But that's the best place to be. That's when we realise that we are just an instrument in the hands of the redeemer. We are not the Redeemer. We are tools in the hands of the Master Carpenter. Ministry does not depend on our strength, but on Christ, who graciously uses weak and limited people for His glory.

3. Burnout refocuses our eyes to the New Creation

Burnouts remind us that we are just passing through this life. Burnouts hurt. Burnouts help us yearn for the day when our joy will be complete and when our hearts are satisfied, when we meet our father who is waiting for us. When he rewards us for our efforts. Burnouts take away the joy we might feel in this fleeting life on earth and place our joy where it rightfully belongs, in the new creation.

When ministry brings us to the end of ourselves, it may feel like failure. But in God's mercy, it can become the place where we rediscover our limits, our need for Christ, and the hope of the

world to come. We are not strong enough for
ministry. But Christ is. And He is enough.

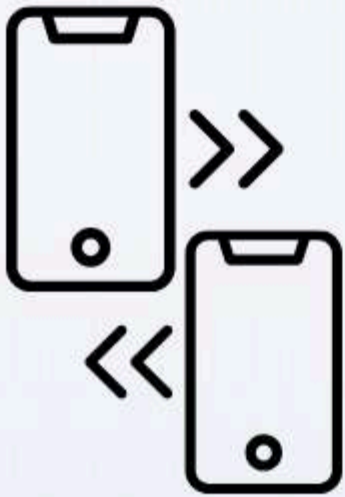

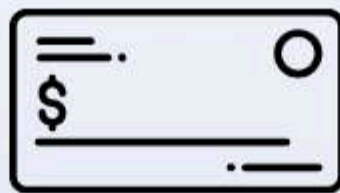
