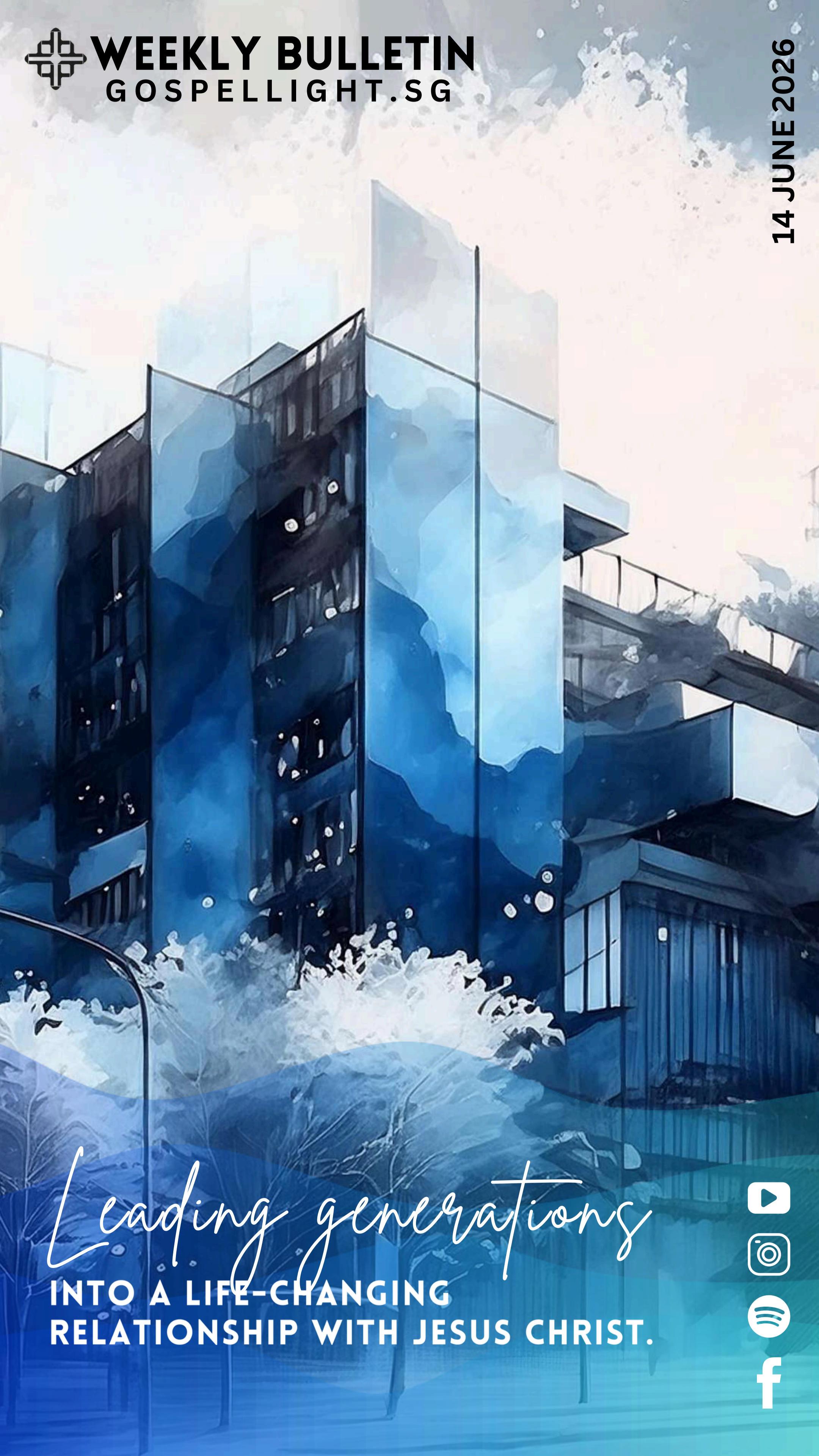

Two Good Gifts in a Confusing Moment

Increasingly more societies are putting marriage and parenthood on indefinite hold. Locally, MSF reported a continued decline in 2024, with shifts coming especially from those in their late-20s to early-30s. The church reflects a similar tension: many singles and fewer weddings.

Amidst the rising anxieties from these statistics, we don't need more panic or pressure. We need to revisit God's design with confidence: Marriage and Singleness are both great gifts. But the joy from both are eclipsed in knowing Jesus.

1. Honor marriage because it is God's good covenant picture

In Genesis 2:18-24, God presents marriage as His unique and benevolent gift to mankind. It is not a matter of social necessity or convenience, it is a gift that reflects the nature of a covenant-making, covenant-keeping God. Its significance will echo through the annals of the old testament in God's commitment to His people: faithfulness, sacrifice, forgiveness and unconditional love will be its hallmarks. In the new testament, marriage becomes the glorious parable of Christ's love for His bride, the church. (Eph. 5:25-32)

So when modern society marginalizes marriage, dilutes its worth or defines it as the loss of freedom and self-identity, believers can speak with biblical clarity: marriage is good, marriage is meaningful, marriage should be pursued with wisdom. But we must balance this with what the gospel teaches - marriage is not our Savior. Our spouses were never intended to carry the full weight of our joy, our identity, our security. Only Jesus can.

The decline of marriage should grieve us, not because marriage saves society or completes the soul, but because it is one of God's good gifts meant to display something greater: the faithful, covenant love of Christ for His people.

2. Honor singleness because it displays Christ's sufficiency

Apostle Paul, wrote passionately about the “undivided devotion” (1 Cor. 7: 32-35) the gift singleness allowed to those blessed with it. Dr Simpson, writing in TGC[^] asserts that we can “value singleness with devaluing marriage.” In essence, both can help our church community see the gospel in more fulness.

This reorder our culture's stigma of singleness as a waiting room or a problem that needs a permanent solution. Instead God reframes this

as His calling, at times for a season, at times for life. But the thread that runs through both is the same – Christ is enough. Jesus himself teaches that in the coming ages His redeemed people, “neither marry nor are given in marriage.” (Mat. 22:3) Singleness becomes a tangible testament: this age is passing away, the best is yet to come, in Christ.

3. Resist two harmful instincts

Two unhelpful things that singles face even in healthy churches are often in either the “no pressure” posture or being ‘sideline’. The “no pressure” posture can leave believers passive or misguided in a culture that undermines marriage. The solution isn’t forcing unions to happen, but journeying with men and women toward maturity, courage, holiness and wisdom. So when marriage is considered, it is framed by God’s will.

Second, we must be careful not to sideline singles. Church life revolves largely around the nuclear family, our single brothers and sisters can feel isolated. True community requires us to

look beyond couples, family only dynamics, removing walls so that unmarried adults are included in everyday hospitality and church rhythms. We must be active to undo the bias that marriage is the only prerequisite for spiritual maturity and that singleness translates to a prolonged adolescence.

A closing encouragement

At the end of the day, our spiritual journey is not a race towards a status. But a call to be faithful to the finish. Honor marriage without idolizing it. Honor singlehood without sympathy framing it. Instead let both point to the sufficiency of Christ, our faithful bridegroom. Until the day the whole church sits at the wedding table of the King. (Rev. 19:6-9).

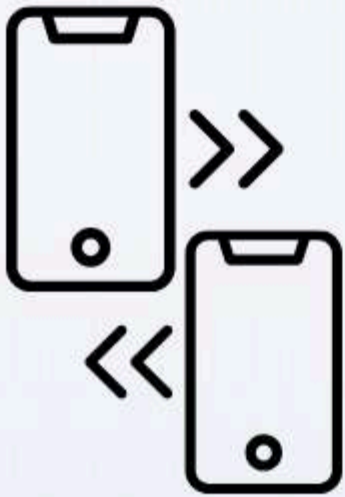

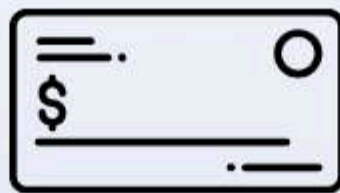
