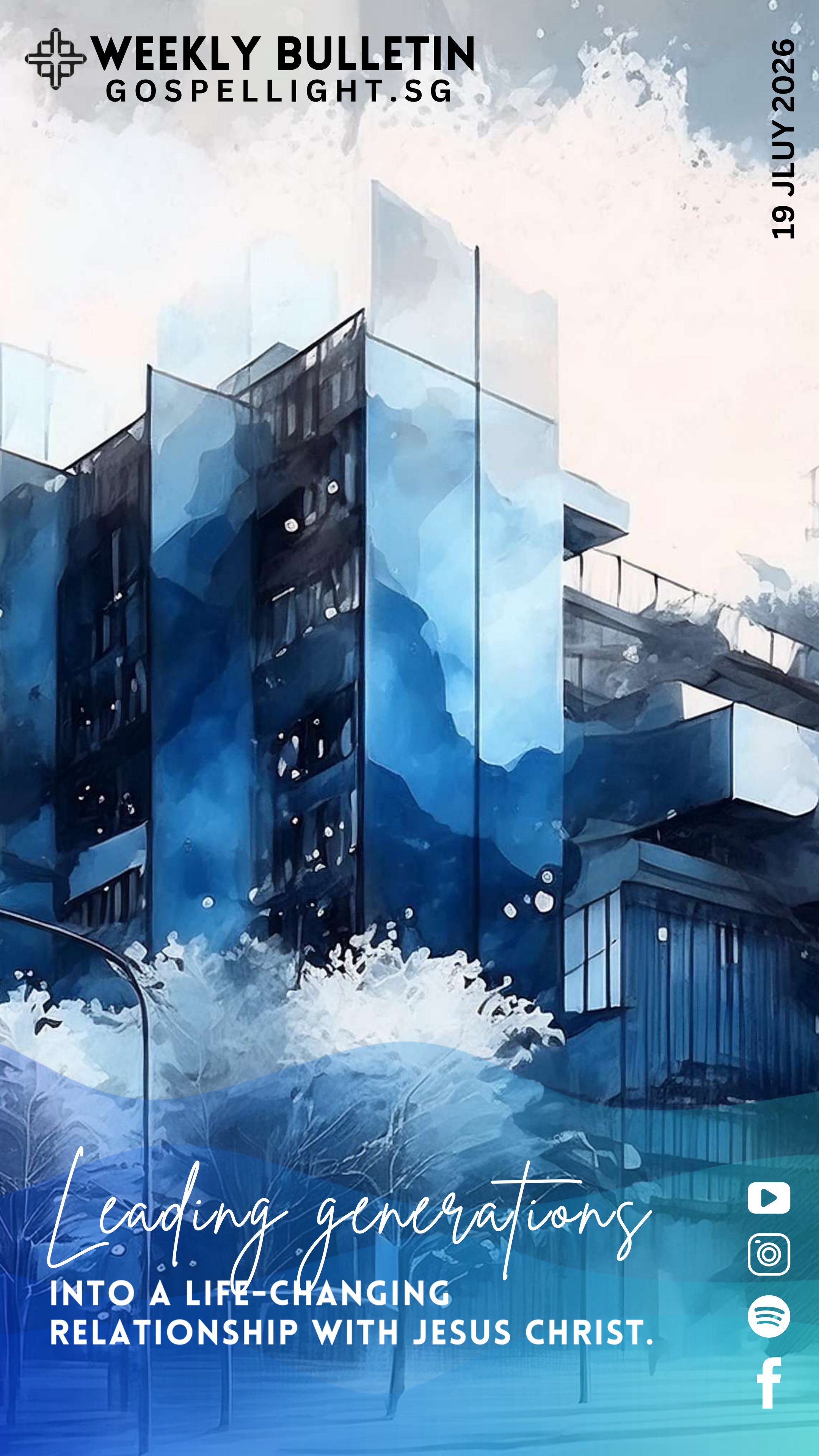

Shepherding a People Far from Home

Just over a year ago, Hanniel Sinon stepped into the role of Filipino Shepherd, continuing a ministry faithfully led by his father. In this follow-up interview, we check in with Hanniel to hear how he has grown into the role, and what God has been teaching and doing among them in this new season.

1. Looking back on your first year in this role, what has most surprised you—about yourself, the congregation, or shepherding?

What has surprised me most is how much shepherding has changed me before it has

changed anyone else. I entered the role expecting to serve and teach, but I have been humbled by how much I still need to grow in patience, listening, and being present.

The congregation has surprised me too. Their resilience, warmth, and faith, even amid change and distance from home, have shown me what trust in God can look like.

2. In what ways have you seen God's faithfulness in the Filipino congregation over the past year?

God's faithfulness has been evident through the congregation's willing spirit of service. When my wife and I welcomed our baby girl and I went on paternity leave, many members stepped forward. They filled ministry gaps, kept things running smoothly, and supported our family with help, including nappies and meals.

No one made a display of it; they simply noticed needs and responded in love. It reminded me that ministry was never meant to rest on one person's shoulders. Seeing the congregation carry the work together was one of the clearest pictures of God's faithfulness this year.

3. What have been some unique joys and challenges of shepherding a transitory congregation?

One joy is seeing people arrive homesick and uncertain, then gradually discover a spiritual family here. The challenge is knowing that many may eventually leave because of work, visas, or family responsibilities.

Just as relationships begin to form, someone may need to move on, and the process begins again. This has taught me to love people fully, even when our season together may be brief, and to trust God with the fruit.

4. What burdens or struggles have become especially clear among members?

Many carry the pressures of life in Singapore: job insecurity, homesickness, and adapting to a new environment. Others face spiritual struggles involving priorities, ministry commitment, and life transitions.

These needs remind us that we are still growing as a church and are not yet where we hope to be. Yet that is not a reason for discouragement. What matters is sincere, steady progress as God continues His work among us.

5. How has stepping into a role once held by your father shaped you?

My father—and my mother too—are deeply missed. Looking back, they made ministry appear effortless, even though they served faithfully for twenty years.

Stepping into his role has shown me that ministry is demanding. It has deepened my appreciation for their perseverance and sacrifice. I have been humbled by the responsibility, and I

hope to serve with the same steadiness, humility, and faithfulness that marked my father's ministry.

6. What do you most long to see God grow in the Filipino congregation next?

I long to see a sense of mission. I pray that we will not see ourselves only as a gathering place where Filipino workers can feel at home, but also as a sending community.

My hope is that the congregation will recognise its place in God's wider work in Singapore—reaching not only fellow Filipinos, but also others around us who need the gospel. I pray that belonging here will lead naturally to serving, witnessing, and helping others find hope in Christ.

7. How can the wider church pray for the congregation, you, and your family?

Please pray that our members will experience belonging, even in a season of transience. Pray for wisdom as I seek to shepherd faithfully while adjusting to a new phase of family life.

Pray also that my family will have the strength and grace to serve wholeheartedly without losing sight of one another. This congregation has become a gift to us, and we are grateful to walk this journey faithfully together with the wider church family.

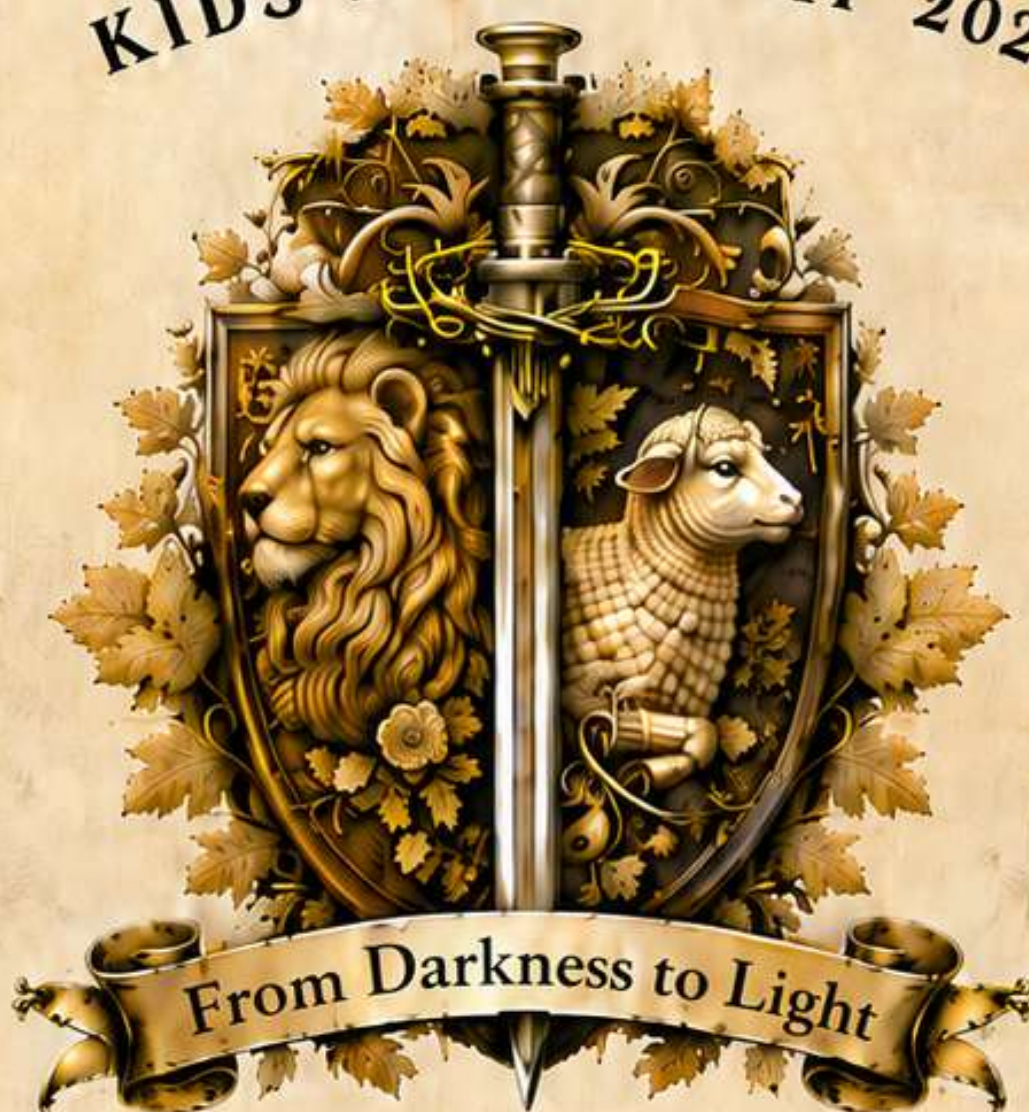

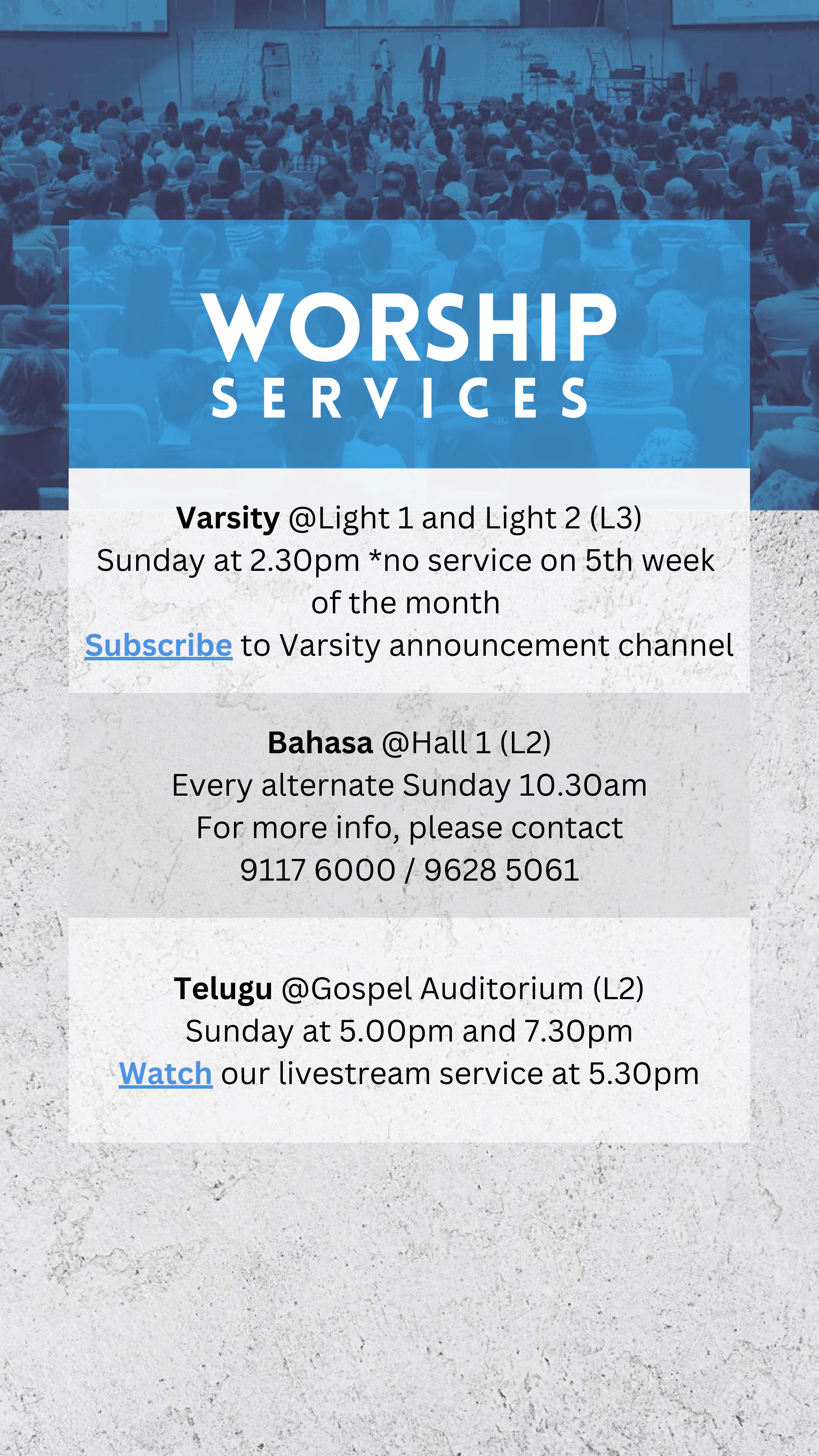

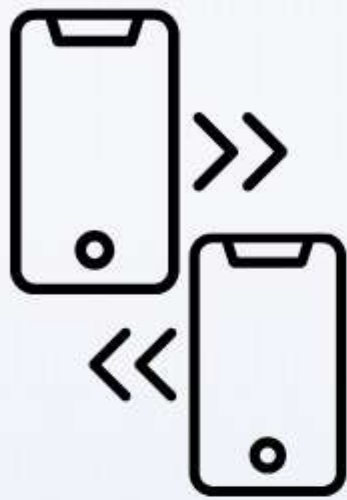
