Understanding the Next Generation: 5 Questions with Our Youth Pastor

The youth in our church are growing up in a world that is changing rapidly. They face pressures that many adults may not fully understand — from identity, sexuality, mental health, academic stress, and the pull of a culture that shapes them faster than the church does.

Yet they are not merely “the future of the church.” They are part of the church now — young disciples who need the loving support of the wider body of Christ.

To help us understand their needs better, we speak with our Youth Pastor, Pastor Yu Fei about the joys and challenges of ministering to young people today.

1. What burdens or pressures do Youth carry that many adults may not realise they are carrying?

Many adults may not realise how much invisible pressure youths carry. Social media constantly invites comparison, telling them they should be smarter, more attractive, successful, or popular. Alongside this is the struggle of identity—trying to discover who they are in a world that urges them to define themselves apart from Christ. Many also face intense academic and personal expectations, fearing failure, judgment, or not being good enough. Though digitally connected, many still experience deep loneliness and isolation.

2. How has youth culture changed in recent years, and how is that shaping young people?

Youth culture has changed dramatically with social media and technology. Previous generations were shaped mainly by family,

school, and close friends; today, youths are influenced daily by countless online voices. Identity is increasingly treated as something to create rather than receive from God. Truth becomes subjective, while relationships can be shaped by convenience and instant gratification. Even views of God may be influenced more by popular opinion than Scripture. These messages are subtle, constant, and powerful in shaping how young people think and live.

3. What are some struggles among Christian youths that the church should be praying about more intentionally?

Many youths genuinely love Jesus and want to follow Him, yet they constantly navigate competing priorities, distractions, and voices. One struggle is maintaining spiritual habits as school, work, and commitments crowd out Scripture, prayer, and Christian community. Many also wrestle honestly with questions about suffering, sexuality, identity, science, and whether Christianity is true. This can be part of developing a faith that becomes their own. Pray that they know Christ personally, remain rooted

in His Word, and follow Him faithfully when it is costly.

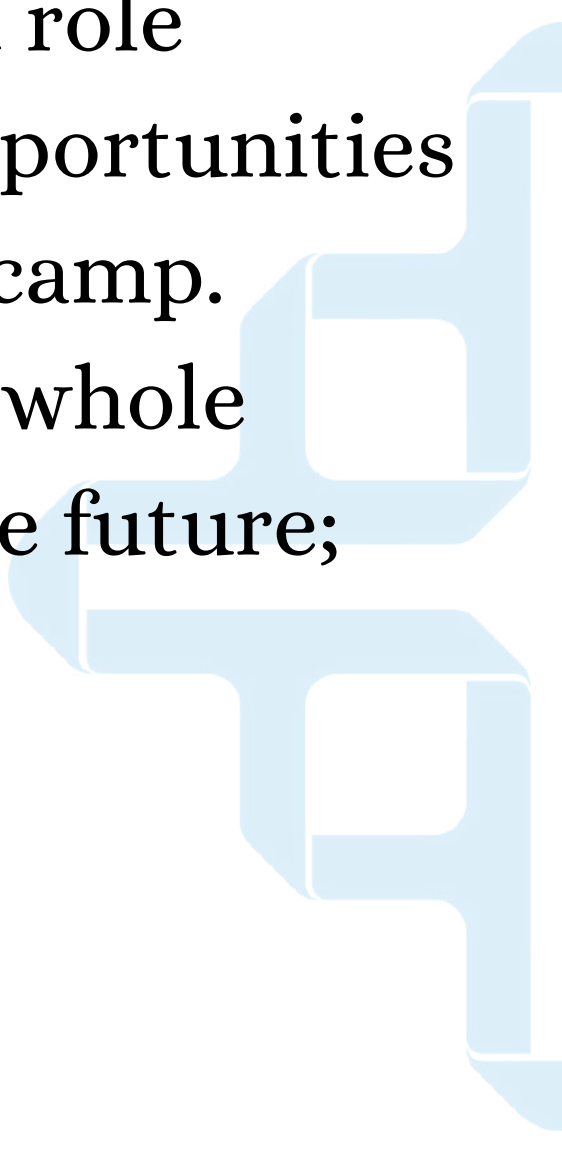


4. What do you wish older members of the church understood better about connecting with youths?

Older members sometimes feel they have little to offer because they are not “cool” enough or do not understand youth culture. But youths are not looking for adults who know every trend. They value people who are genuine, willing to listen, and interested in their lives. Discipleship often begins with presence before advice. A remembered detail, simple question, or prayer can communicate deep care. They need faithful adults who will walk alongside them and point them to Christ through both words and example. Their questions deserve patience, honesty, and thoughtful biblical engagement.

5. What are some practical ways the wider church can support the Youth Congregation beyond just saying, “We are praying for you”?

Please keep praying—it truly matters. But let prayer lead to presence. Learn our youths’ names, ask about school, work, or National Service, and take a genuine interest in their lives. Share your own experiences of God’s faithfulness; they do not need perfect role models, but faithful ones. Look for opportunities to serve at youth services, events, or camp. Youth ministry is the privilege of the whole church. Our youths are not merely the future; they are part of the church today.

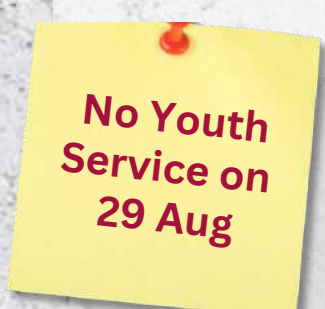

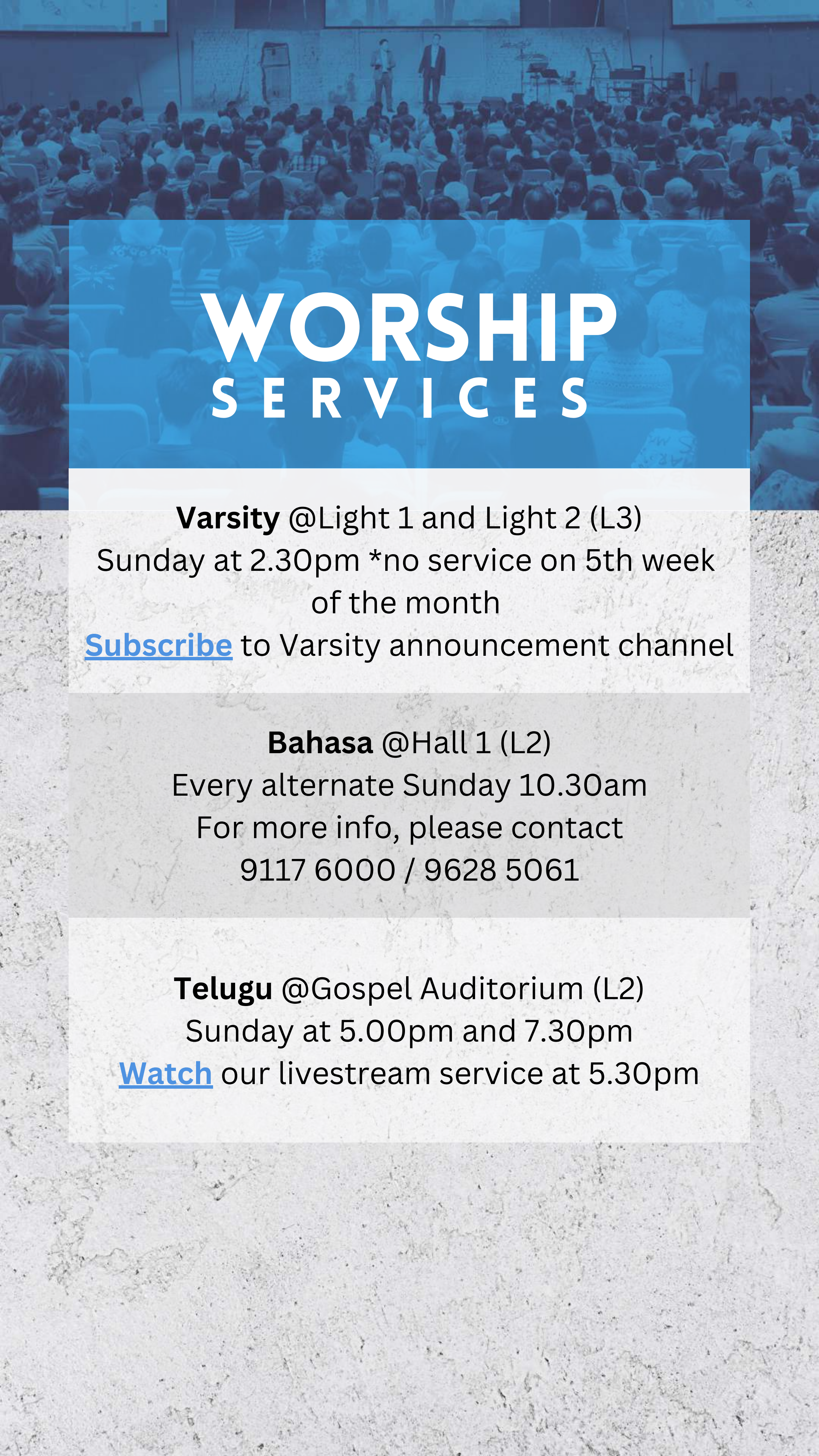

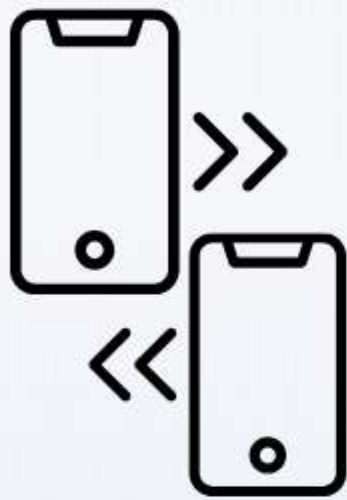
